
Loading Quality:

All loads must have a rounded top lower than the stakes. No cross piling, mud, brush, etc., will be allowed in the road. All trucks must have four (4) solid stakes. Trailers loaded length ways required 2 feet of clearance between tiers. All wood must be secured with 2 binders.

Safety: Drivers will take directions from Company staff and obey all safety order while on company property. Please see next page for further information on safety.

<u>Appendix "D'</u> <u>Safety Orders for Logyard</u>

- Speed limit 20 km/h
- Safety hat, boots, eye protection and hi-visibility vest are required
- Log trucks must have lights on at all times while in the Logyard
- 20 lb. Fire extinguisher (or equivalent capacity) on all mobile equipment
- No smoking or littering
- Loads are to be rounded with all wood lower than stakes
- All wood deliveries are to be neatly loaded with <u>2 binders</u> on each pile
- Length-ways loads require clearance between tiers
- All loaded vehicles parked on an incline must have parking brake applied and either the driver in the cab or chocks immediately installed upon exiting the cab
- Passengers must remain in cab at all times
- A 360° walk-around must be performed before removing binders
- Binders are only to be removed after leaving scales
- No walking on top of loads or wood piles
- Self-Loaders directed to Hot Pond unloading area <u>must not</u> raise their booms until they are at the unloading area due to overhead power lines
- Drivers must stay in cab while getting unloaded
- Truckers are required to use stairs and avoid crossing empty truck boxes or trailers at scalehouse when weighing out
- Accidents/Spills must be reported immediately to the scaler
- Truck beds are to be thoroughly cleaned in the designated clean-off
- area after weighing out

No trimming of wood allowed on Arbee property

• Failure to comply with Logyard safety orders will result in disciplinary action

St. Stephen Yard: This yard is run by HC Haynes Inc. Take exit 4, at stop sign turn right onto Church St., travel $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to stop sign & yard is straight ahead.

Penobsquis Yard: This yard is run by Karl Von Waldow. Route 114, west of Picadilly Road. Hours are Monday-Thursday 6AM-6PM. Fridays 6AM-5PM.

Age: Maximum of 3 months off the stump and cut from live trees.

Quality:	SWEEP -	Stems must be able to pass through an 8'cylinder 30" in diameter for $8' - 16'$ and an 8' cylinder 25" in diameter for
		treelength.

- **KNOTS -** Knots must be trimmed flush with the stem.
- ROT 8'-16' up to 1/3 of diameter. TL - Rot should be kept to a minimum. Firm heart rot is acceptable. Hollow heart is acceptable as long as there is 3" of sound wood surrounding the hole.

UNACCEPTABLE - Forks, crotches, doglegs, brush, splits, burned or charred wood, excessive crooks, and butt flare.

DISCOUNTS: No discounts or deductions will be made for defects but if, in the Scaler's judgement, the load does not meet the above Wood Quality Specifications, it will be rejected.

<u>NOTE</u>: 8-foot wood needs to be hauled separately from the long wood due to the wood handling system at Woodland.

Wood Specifications & Delivery Request

Proper Loading

All roundwood loads should be prepared for unloading by overhead cranes.

- 1. Headboards
 - A. Headboards are required on all log trucks.
 - B. Headboard must extend 12" above cab.
 - C. Inadequate headboard protection could result in cab damage. Claims for tractor damage will be denied if headboard protection is inadequate.
 - D. Tops should not stick over headboard.
- 2. Stakes Trailer stakes should be a minimum of 8' apart.
- 3. Load height

All pieces must rest with at least one half of their diameter below the top of any trailer stake.

- 4. Bunks
 - A. Bunks on frame trailers must be at least 8' above top of the frame.
 - B. <u>Trailers must be equipped with risers at least 6" thick and firmly attached to</u> the trailer.
 - C. Multiple Bunks cut to length loads should have 1 foot separation between bunks to allow inspection.
- 5. Tiers
 - A. Two tier and Split loads All loads with butts both ways must be equipped with two (2) dividers between the tiers. The front divider must be at least 8" thick and the rear divider must be at least 12" thick. The bottom tier should have the butts facing forward.
 - B. Single Tier No load dividers are required on single tier loads with all butts facing forward.
 - C. Risers –Bottom Tier must have at least 6" risers unless drop deck or rail frame leaves room for grapple bite.
 - D. All bottom and single tier loads should be loaded butts forward unless prior arrangement with your Procurement Forester has been made.
- 6. Securing Loads Loads must meet State of Maine requirements for binding and securing the load to the trailer.

Safety Gear for Truck Drivers

The following Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required for all drivers entering the mill property. All drivers delivering to mills must be prepared to exit their trucks.

- 1. Hard Hat
- 2. Safety shoes or boots
- 3. Safety glasses with side shields or safety goggles
- 4. Safety Vest

Shorts and sandals are not acceptable. Guards at the specific mills will enforce this policy – Scalers will warn drivers when they observe inadequate dress or PPE. All PPE must meet or exceed current OSHA or MSA specifications. Tyvek coveralls appropriate for one time use are available for purchase at the scale house.

Safety Requirements and Mill Site Procedures

- 1. Do not unbind or uncover your load until inside the mill at the area designated for unbinding or uncovering.
 - A. Fulghum After crossing railroad tracks
 - B. Kraft Mill Beside or in front of chip dumpers
- 2. If any piece of the load extends more than half the diameter of that piece above stakes, the load will be refused for unloading.
- 3. Stop at marked Railroad Crossings.
- 4. Do not stop on railroad tracks your truck, trailer, and load must be at least 10 feet clear of any track when your vehicle stops. Orange flashing light signals train operating in area.
- 5. Observe posted speed limits and stop signs. Other drivers and pedestrians are counting on your compliance.
- 6. Drivers are to exit their trucks and stand two trucks lengths clear of unloading operations unless the loader operator instructs otherwise. At Fulghum, drivers are to be in the yellow driver hut.
- 7. At Fulghum, the drivers hut has a CB radio for communications with the loader operator. You can assist the loader operator by use of this radio.
- 8. Clean off trucks after leaving scale house in the designated area ask crane operator for instructions.
- 9. If you are injured in any way on the mill site report it to the nearest mill personnel.
- 10. If you are involved in an accident, or observe an accident, report it immediately to the nearest mill personnel.

Damage During Unloading

- 1. If your equipment is damaged during unloading immediately report the damage to the loader operator.
- 2. The loader operator will instruct you where to go to complete reporting.
 - a. Fulghum Fibers.... Mark Seavey or Shift Supervisor
 - b. Kraft Mill.... Operator or Guard House
- 3. Do **<u>NOT</u>** leave the mill premises before reporting any damage.
- 4. Scalers are not able to assist in reporting damage to equipment. If a loader operator tells you there is a risk of damage because of the way a load was prepared, unloading proceeds at the driver's option; however, any subsequent damage will not be covered by Fulghum Fibers, or Woodland Pulp LLC.

Additional Information for Drivers

- 1. A bathroom is available for truck drivers at the Scale House. This is the only toilet near unloading facilities.
- 2. Passengers are not allowed on mill property unless the contractor delivering wood employs them. Adult passengers may wait in the Scale House.
- 3. Pets are not allowed on mill property.
- 4. Weapons of any sort are not allowed on mill property.
- 5. Trailers are to be cleaned off in the designated area beside the Scale House. Risers may be discarded here also.

AV Group - Load Quality and Safety



Load Quality

- All loads must have a rounded top, level or lower than the top of the stakes.
- No cross piling, mud, brush, etc., will be allowed in the load.
- All trucks must have a minimum of four (4) solid stakes.
- Trailers loaded lengthways require 2 feet of clearance between tiers.
- Flat-bed trailers must be equipped with 20cmor 8"risers for each bunk.
- All trucks require a Headboard. The Headboard must extend 12" above the cab of the truck, Any damage occurring to truck cabs not equipped with adequate headboard, AV Group will not be responsible.
- Loads may not extend forward past the headboard.
- Stakes must be positioned to provide the loaders access to the center of each bunk.

Safety

- Drivers must wear all required personal protective equipment while outside their trucks on AV Group property. This includes CSA certified Hard Hat, Steel toe boots, reflective clothing and safety glasses.
- Trailer must be cleaned of all debris before leaving site in the designated clean off area.
- Drivers will follow instructions from AV staff and obey all safety orders while on company property.
- Self-loading trucks are <u>not permitted</u> to drive with their boom straight up after their load has been unloaded. All truckers are to pull away from the log deck or the loader (~100') allowing the next truck in line to commence unloading and lower their booms; i.e. away from the potential of falling logs.

Note: This is a change from current practice due to the recent incidents of drivers coming into contact with power lines.

Unacceptable: Loads containing more than 5% rot.

Individual pieces with greater than 50% diameter rot. No forked pieces or excessively crooked pieces. No burned or charred wood.

Loads containing more than 5% rot shall be rejected. Individual pieces with greater than 50% diameter rot are unacceptable. Defective bolts within accepted loads may be deducted from the dale at the discretion of the scale staff on duty.

Note:

Loads may be rejected by JDI scale staff prior to unloading if they do not meet minimum specifications. Quality (% acceptable pieces) shall be measured using the above specifications. Any supplier whose quality sample results fall below 60% for any one (1) load, or fall below 85% for any three (3) loads delivered within a 4 week period, shall be place on QUALITY SUSPENSION and deliveries immediately suspended. Suppliers on quality suspension shall not be allowed to resume delivery until approved by the Regional Wood Buyer.

The trucker or producer must notify the JDI scale staff or Chief Scaler of any disputes regarding scale or sample selection at the time of delivery. JDI will make best efforts to hold quality samples for 24 hours when results fall below 85% to allow time for inspection. These specifications are subject to change by JDI with minimum notice.

SCALE PROCEDURES									
When trucks arrive at the scales, the driver selects raw material inbound load. The driver will then be asked to enter driver card number (to unlock computer). The supplied bar code for SNB Marketing Board can be used or simply enter 9413. This will open the screen with supply contract #968 (SNB Marketing Board) Press ENTER, then another screen appears where to enter driver information and License Plate number. ENTER again prints out Ticket (2-yard pass). Proceed to TAC yard #2 to unload and return to mill scales to weigh out with the Yard Pass. Select Raw Material Outbound and scan yard pass bar code. Three tickets will be printed with information. Trucker is to staple one of the yard passes, the outbound ticket to the BOL/Transportation Certificate and place in the box provided for payment. Yard personnel for TAC and Arauco Security staff are on site to assist.
