- 2"-3" Sound knot One Defect
- Larger Sound Knots- one or more defects depending on log size and quality. Other knots will be graded as they affect quality of the log.
- A three foot tight seam is acceptable in birch.
- Burls, swells, cat faces, dote, checking, shake, work track, mineral, grubs and spiral grain are defects and will be graded as they affect the value of the log.
- Two defects in a straight line will be graded as a one defect log.

- No sweep in 9", 10", 11" log. -
- No butt swell or excessive flare.
- In logs 12" to 14" in diameter, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " of sweep will be allowed. In logs 15" and over, 3" sweep is acceptable. Necessary scale deductions will be made.
- All logs not meeting lengths specified will be cut back to next acceptable length. Need to have full 5" trim.
- Length of logs will be measured from top of scarf.


