### Defect Description:






- 2"-3" Sound knot – One Defect
- Larger Sound Knots- one or more defects depending on log size and quality. Other knots will be graded as they affect quality of the log.
- A three foot tight seam is acceptable in birch.
- Burls, swells, cat faces, dote, checking, shake, work track, mineral, grubs and spiral grain are defects and will be graded as they affect the value of the log.
- Two defects in a straight line will be graded as a one defect log.
- No sweep in 9", 10", 11" log.
- No butt swell or excessive flare.
- In logs 12" to 14" in diameter, 1 ½" of sweep will be allowed. In logs 15" and over, 3" sweep is acceptable. Necessary scale deductions will be made.
- All logs not meeting lengths specified will be cut back to next acceptable length. Need to have full 5" trim.
- Length of logs will be measured from top of scarf.

1. Logs must be cut from live standing trees, have **2 Clear Faces and be Sound**.
2. Dry, dead and hollow logs and logs containing worm holes, splits, shakes, seams, conk and punk or punk knots will be rejected in most cases except as seen below.
3. Logs may contain up to 10% sweep but logs with short sharp crooks will be rejected.
4. All butts must be trimmed of excessive flare, butt hinge, stump pull and notches and be sawn straight and square.
5. Veneer cut while trees are in leaf out (May & June) must be delivered in the following month and within two months at any other time of the year.
