Specifications for all grades:

All logs must be cut from live trees. Logs not within length specs are unacceptable and shall be scaled the next shorter length acceptable or rejected. Rejected logs must be picked up by the supplier within 48 hours of notification or they will be disposed of. During the summer months, logs must be delivered within a couple days of harvest, otherwise within 3 months.

No forked logs. No burned or charred wood. No stain or insect/worm damage. Knots and butt flare trimmed flush with log. Excessively knotty logs will be rejected. All defects will be deducted from scaled volume including: damage, rot, sweep, seams, porcupine chews, or other defects. Logs with 50% or more defect volume will be rejected. Maximum sweep is 1" per 4-feet of log length. Forked ends and sharp crooks are not acceptable. All knots and excessive butt flare must be trimmed close to the log. Maximum allowable sweep is 1 inch per 4 feet of length. Length of a log much be marked on the top end of each log.

GRADE 16 ALL 16' (16'3' to 16'60) must meet Grade 1 Specs.

GRADE 1

DIAMETER: Minimum top -10° , Maximum butt 40° (inside bark)

LENGTH: 12' and 16" with 3-6 of trim

MAXIMIM KNOT SIZE: Up to 1 inch; no knot clusters

MAXIMUM ROT: Less that ¼ diameter of log.

SEAM: One straight seam acceptable

PORCUPINE DAMAGE: Not acceptable.

GRADE 2

DIAMETER: Minimum top – 8.0", Maximum butt 40" (inside bark)

LENGTH: 10′, 12′, 14′ and 16″ with 3-6 of trim

MAXIMIM KNOT SIZE: Red knots up to 3 inches; black knots up to 2 inches; no knot clusters

MAXIMUM ROT: Less that ¼ diameter of log.

SEAM: One straight seam acceptable

PORCUPINE DAMAGE: Not acceptable.

GRADE 3

DIAMETER: Minimum top – 6.0", Maximum butt 40" (inside bark)

LENGTH: 10', 12', 14' and 16" with 3-6 of trim

MAXIMIM KNOT SIZE: Red knots up to 3 inches; black knots up to 2 inches; cluster knots on not more

than 2 faces.

MAXIMUM ROT: Less that ¼ diameter of log.

SEAM: One straight seam acceptable

PORCUPINE DAMAGE: Not acceptable.
