Studwood Specifications

GRADE 19 (9 foot studs) and GRADE 18 (8 foot studs)	
Species	Spruce/fir only; minimum 60% spruce, maximum 40% fir (white wood only)
Age	Delivered within 3 months of date cut (live trees at time of cut)
Length	9' studs = 108" to 112" Loads may contain up to 20% 8-foot studs 8' studs+ 99" to 103"
Diameter	9' studs= 5" minimum top to 13" maximum butt (inside bark) 8' studs= 4.5" minimum top to 13" maximum butt (inside bark)
Defects	No rot, no forked bolts, ends cut square. Taper or sweep must be less than 2" over the length of the bolt. In any 4-foot section of a bolt: not more than 12 knots 1" to 3" diameter OR not more than 8 knots > 3" diameter.
GRADE 29 (9 foot studs) and GRADE 28 (8 foot studs)	
Species	Less than 60% Spruce. Jack Pine is acceptable in full loads, or separated on the truck to the Sussex Mill only.
NOTE:	Loads may be rejected by JDI scale staff prior to unloading if they do not meet minimum specifications. Grade shall be determined by JDI, based on a 40+ piece sample extracted randomly from each load and measured using the above specifications (if spruce content in the sample is less than 60% the load shall be assessed as Grade 29 or 28. Quality (% acceptable pieces) shall be measured using the above specifications. Loads assessed as 90% or higher may be eligible for a QUALITY BONUS where applicable under contract terms or as determined by JD Irving Limited. Any supplier whose quality sample results fail below 60% for any one (1) load, or fall below 85% for any three (3) loads delivered within a 4-week period, shall be placed on QUALITY SUSPENSION and deliveries immediately suspended. Suppliers on quality suspension shall not be allowed to resume delivery until approved by the Regional Wood Buyer.

Contracts: Additional \$/GMT is available for signed contracts with committed volumes. Performance bonuses for individuals who fill 90% of their contract commitment is also available.

When drivers arrive with their first load of NB wood they must talk to Shawn, Donald, or Stephen in the scalehouse and sign off on a declaration about our procedures for accepting and stocking the studwood in a special area of our yard.

Our loader operators must be alerted they have NB wood and then will be unloaded in the correct area or will be directed to unload themselves.

Due to the importance of segregating the wood in our yard, **the hours for delivery of NB studwood at this time will be 7:00AM to 4:30PM Monday to Friday.**

Transportation certificates are mandatory and 1 copy must be left with the scalehouse.

Thanks for your cooperation on jumping through these hoops to make deliveries possible, we appreciate your business.
