Summary of 2025 Capital Improvement Project:

As we have settled into our new church building, we have continued to assess the needs of our church building and after continuing to receive feedback for improvements from the congregation. Thanks to generous designated donations in 2024, we are thankful to be able to make these needed improvements that will enhance our worship experience and make our church more welcoming to all members and visitors. We have allocated the funds towards the completion of the following top priorities.

Below is what the money in 2024, will be used for:

- Paint the Sanctuary wood paneling and ceiling -- \$22,500
- Reconfigure the stage area in the Sanctuary -- \$22,500
- Update & repair the balcony area in the Sanctuary -- \$15,000
- Continue improvements on electronics -- \$15,000
