- Wipes
- Pre-made Bottles (name and date should be on each bottle)
- Bottle Bag
- 3 Pairs of extra clothes (socks too)
- Bibs
- Diaper Cream
- Water Bottle/Empty Bottle or cup

Families, please provide a nutritional diet for you infant. All foods, including baby formula, milk, jar foods, cereals and snacks are to be supplied and labeled by the parent. You may keep back up formula in their diaper bag for emergencies. Please make sure you have given VIP an Infant Feeding Plan and update it as you start introducing new food to you child.

Our teachers will be communicating not only at drop- off but also through the Tadpoles app. There you can let our staff know of any bottles, foods or diapers given prior to drop- off. As a parent you can also leave special notes for the teachers to read. Our staff will input all bottles/ food given, naps, diapers, and their daily health check. You will also see photos and or videos that have been taken that day. Since accidents sometimes happen, please make sure you pack 3 changes of clothes for your child.

We are so thrilled to start the new school year with so many new faces! We are looking forward to watching your child grow and develop throughout the year. If you should have any questions or concerns, please feel free to ask.
