

A Season of Hope

I cried out to the Lord telling Him I did not know how I was going to get through it all. I was in so much pain it hurt to breath. In this moment of despair God spoke these words to my heart:

"Rejoice, rejoice in the Savior's birth, for God has made the way for you to be with Him and with one another for all eternity. For though you made be separated for a time, you will be together forever."

When I heard these words, in a moment, my soul was infused with hope and I was immediately strengthen. And that strength remains to this day. Though at times I feel sadness the 'rejoicing' still remains and strengthens me. For the 'joy of the Lord is our strength'.

I believe that in that moment God poured His love into my heart through His Holy Spirit and that these words filled my heart with hope which strengthened me and enabled me to do what needed to be done at that time and prepared me for my husband's passing.
