



Islamic Relief Presents: The Student Humanitarian Award

This award is an opportunity for Muslim high school students across Alberta to be recognized for their contributions in serving the Muslim community and community at large. Islamic Relief and MYS will be accepting applications that show what active participation in the community is and that showcase the impact it can have. The student chosen for this year's award will be recognized on April 1st and 2nd, 2026 at the Muslim Youth Summit.

Judging criteria shall be based on:

1. Involvement in voluntary humanitarian activities (for which they have not been compensated)
2. Number and type of activities involved in
3. Level of involvement and impact of involvement
4. Team leadership and service to community

Students must submit their completed portfolio and write up by March 2nd, 2026 through [this Google Form](#).

Part 1: Portfolio

Describe the initiative(s), achievement(s), and excellence of your involvement in the community. This portfolio can be presented in any way you would like including a video, slide show, newsletter, or document.

Part 2: Write up

List all voluntary or extra-curricular activities (community, school, organizations, etc) that you have been involved with in the past year. This write up should not exceed 3 pages typed and can be in point form or essay format. In the write up please include how your participation in these activities aligns with the concept of servitude in Islam.

Please ensure that your portfolio and/or write up covers all four areas of the judging criteria.
