



## **Quran Recitation Competition**

## **Registration Requirements:**

- 1. Students must submit their initial entry prior to April 11, 2025.
- 2. Students must submit a video recording of their recitation of verses 41-45 of al-Anfal **and** verses 32-36 of an-Nur through <u>this Google Form.</u>
- 3. The top 3 successful students will be selected for the live competitive performance at the Muslim Youth Summit on April 17th, 2025.

## Procedure

- 1. Judging for the top 3 competitors will take place at the Muslim Youth Summit on April 17th, 2025.
- 2. The focus of the competition is Quran recitation and Tajweed, NOT memorization. Competitors will be permitted to read directly from the Mushaf
- 3. Competitors will be expected to recite two (2) passages live during their performance from any part of the Quran.
  - a. Judges will tell the competitor where to start the recitation and where to stop.
  - b. The passages will be selected by the judges at the time of the competition and can be from any surah in the Quran.
  - c. Competitors must be proficient in reciting any verse in the Quran.
- 4. A panel of judges will score each competitor and select Alberta's Top Youth Quran Reciter.

## Marking Criteria:

- 1. 1 mark will be deducted if the recitation is not fluent
- 2. **1 mark** will be deducted for correcting one's own mistake and **half mark** for correcting one's own tajweed mistakes
- 3. Marks will be deducted if the Examiner has to correct the mistake as follows:
  - **1 mark** will be deducted for mistakes in the rules of Tajweed (*lahn-khafi*) e.g. ghunnah, qalqalah, tafkheem and tarqeeq, madd, etc.
  - **2 marks** will be deducted for lahn-jali or clear mistakes e.g. Makharij al-Huruf, adding or deleting a word or a letter, replacing a word or a letter with a different one, changing the harakat, ignoring Shaddah, etc.
