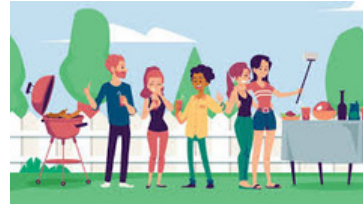

Certified Level One Arboretum!

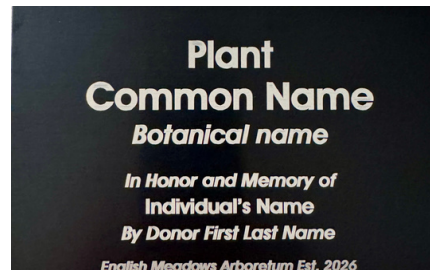
You have a unique opportunity to participate in this project!

The location of your tree will be added to the arboretum map that will be
posted on our neighborhood website The Meadows Memo.

A beautiful 4 X 6 laser engraved anodized aluminum sign
will be nailed to the tree trunk using an aluminum nail
at about eye level for a medium height adult.
The nail isn't driven all the way into the tree, allowing space for the tree to
grow without "eating" the sign.
The memorial sponsorship fee is only \$50.



If you would like to sponsor a tree without adding a memorial,
the fee is only \$25 and will display
the common name and botanical name only.

A Piece of English Meadows History by Edna Guntert

Our English Meadows neighborhood was named after the landowner Joseph English, who had a farm on the property and primarily grew corn. Richard Sasser, who lived on McVay near Riverdale, grew up on his family's 30 acre farm which is now Rico, Chico and Toro. He remembers listening to Mr. English driving his tractor late into the evening.

The land was sold in the early 1960's and phase one was developed by L. Hall Jones of the Joyner-Heard Company. The entrance way at Riverdale and Poplar Pike was designed by Everett H. Woods, architect.

On the eastern side of the entrance there is a cast stone sign depicting a lion and a unicorn supporting a circular shield cut into quarters. The British Lion is displayed in both the upper left and lower right area, while the upper right has the Fleur-de-lis and the lower left shows the Irish Harp. Around the circular shield, quoted in French, is the motto of the British Knights of the Garter, "Honi Soit Qui Mal Y Pense" meaning "Shamed Be He Who Thinks Evil Of It". Above the words "English Meadows" it states in French, "Dieu et Mon Droit" translated "God and My Right".
