Before submitting a fund request, please verify that your fund has a spendable balance as of August 15. If you are unsure if any funds have been used, please email either Jeremy Ried ([jried@alphasig.org](mailto:jried@alphasig.org)) or Sam Harris ([sharris@alphasig.org](mailto:sharris@alphasig.org)).

The next published update will be available no later than February 15.

1. Log-in to [myAlphaSig](#).
2. From the top left of the page, select “Fund Request” from the Forms drop-down menu.
3. Complete the form for your request. To expedite the approval process, have an Alumni Association officer complete the form. Also be sure to include any receipts or supporting documentation.
  1. If an individual is receiving funds via scholarship or reimbursement, please complete and submit the Statement of Eligibility and include with this request.

Fraternity staff will review all completed requests in a timely manner.
