- 1. Log-in to myAlphaSig.
- 2. From the top left of the page, select "Fund Request" from the Forms drop-down menu.
- Complete the form for your request. To expedite the approval process, have an Alumni Association officer complete the form. Also be sure to include any receipts or supporting documentation.
 - If an individual is receiving funds via scholarship or reimbursement, please complete and submit the Statement of Eligibility and include with this request.

Fraternity staff will review all completed requests in a timely manner.
