


Expansion efforts at California State University at Bakersfield began during the spring semester of 2017. Coordinator of Expansion Mike Carlo, Illinois State '13, led the expansion on campus and recruited 31 men. On April 1, 2017, 28 men were initiated into Alpha Sigma Phi and became Founding Fathers of the lota Alpha Provisional Chapter. Nick Fequiere, CSU-Bakersfield '17, served as the founding President from the installation through August of 2018.

lota Alpha closed in spring 2022 after failing to meet obligations to the Fraternity.






Expansion efforts at St. Mary's University were started in spring 2017.

The Provisional Chapter Ceremony was conducted on April 8, 2017 by Assistant Director Grothause and was attend by the Grand Chapter Advisor and guests from the Theta Iota Chapter at Texas State University and the Eta Theta Chapter at University of Texas – San Antonio. 








Expansion efforts CSU - San Marcos began in the spring of 2018 led by Coordinator of Expansion and Growth Sam Franzoia, Chico State '12.






As of May 2020, the lota Phi Chapter began to operate independently from Texas A&M, Corpus Christi.
