

KAPPA ALPHA CHAPTER RHODE ISLAND COLLEGE

In the fall of 2018, Coordinator of Expansion Scott McKay, North Carolina '15, began expansion efforts at Rhode Island College. By the end of the semester, 9 men were initiated into Alpha Sigma Phi.

On February 1, 2019, the Interest Group was installed as the Kappa Alpha Provisional Chapter of Alpha Sigma Phi. Coordinator of Undergraduate Engagement Ryan Ruiz, Elmhurst '14, represented Fraternity Staff. Justin Gist, Rhode Island '18, was the Provisional Chapter President at the time of installation.





In Spring 2019, Coordinator of Expansion and Growth Brett Carlson, Illinois State '14 led expansion efforts at The University Hawai'i, recruiting 16 men and making Alpha Sigma Phi the first NIC fraternity on campus, joining two other international fraternities. 




KAPPA ETA CHAPTER ALABAMA - BIRMINGHAM


