



The **Burns Executive Leadership Institute** is a multi-year personal and professional development program designed for high-caliber brothers who will join Fraternity staff upon graduation.

This initiative is named after Ralph F. Burns, Ohio Wesleyan '32, who dedicated over 60 years of his life to the Old Gal, serving as her Executive Secretary for 40+ years and in a volunteer role for 20+ years upon retirement. He was known by thousands of brothers and was often called "Mr. Alpha Sig." He passed into the Omega Chapter in 1993.

Three cohorts will be established (by year), with no more than 10 members per cohort. Individuals in these cohorts will receive executive coaching throughout the year, and will also form relationships with current Fraternity staff and board members to prepare brothers to be successful members of Alpha Sigma Phi National Staff upon graduation.
