HEALTH & SAFETY UPDATE

All Alpha Sigma Phi Chapters are required to completed health and safety training and education within 30 days of the start of the academic term.

Chapters will either complete Responsible SIG, an in-person health and safety training facilitated by the Chapter Advisor or Fraternity Staff, or Tightrope, an online health and safety training. All training covers our Health and Safety Guidelines, Amnesty Policy, Creating a Culture of Accountability and Mental Health.

A total of 97 chapters will complete Responsible SIG, 76 will complete Tightrope and the rest received an exemption.
