It should be administered at the end of every term, preferably at the second to last chapter meeting, so that the information can be reviewed by the Prudential Board and the results should be presented to the chapter at the final chapter meeting of the term.

- Chapter officers are expected to meet higher standards to provide evidence that they strive to improve the quality of leadership and set an example for membership.
- Chapter has a discipline process for members below the minimum GPA. Chapter house has a resource room or library.
- Chapter encourages members to use the university libraries and study facilities.
- Chapter has a calendar of events, showing that chapter members are able to lead a balanced life of academic commitment, social opportunities, and free time.
- The Vice President of Membership Enrichment regularly reviews the scholarship program as well as the chapter's academic progress each semester.

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
