

So we don't grow as many grapes as we do ears of corn. The Sandhills provide an excellent environment to grow high quality grapes. Our grapes grow in sandy soils, a different climate and different elevation. The sandy soils provide excellent drainage. The semi-arid climate provides a growing environment with low humidity, hot summers days, cool nights, plenty of wind and very cold winters that contributes to applying less herbicide, insecticide and fungicide. The elevation of the vineyards is 3300 feet and the vineyard is placed on a south facing slope with air flow to the Niobrara River.
