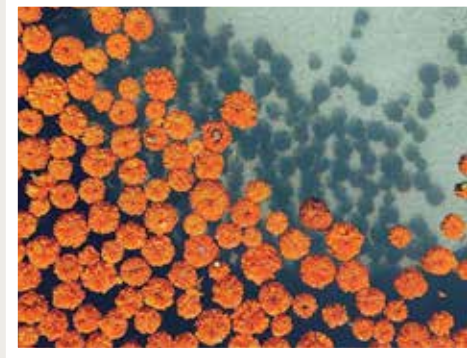

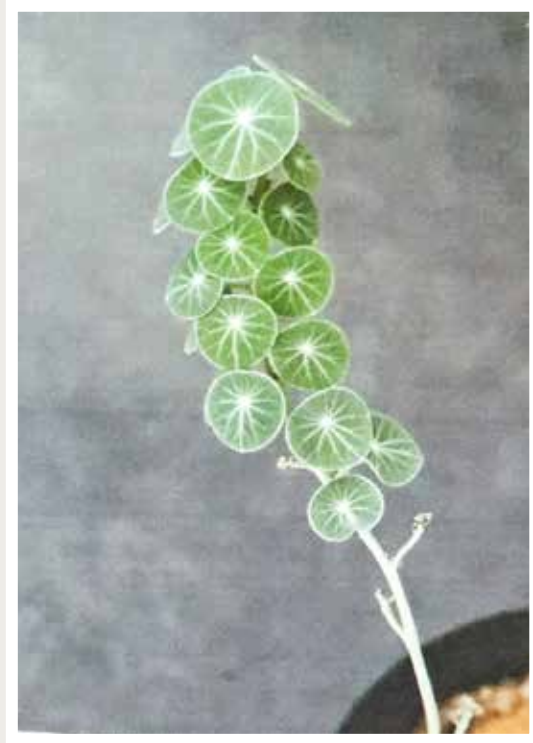

Everything we weave begins with TerraStrand, the name of our proprietary extruded yarns. We develop the colors of each yarn for every weave we design, and we have the unique ability to extrude two colors within a single strand of yarn. These extraordinary “bi-color” yarns are used strategically when designing a weave, so that colors seem to appear and disappear, providing subtle shading, depth, and dimension.





Rethinking Green

Abundant in nature, the color green is often overlooked for interiors. Creative director Sandy Chilewich and the Chilewich design team recently took a fresh look at the cool hue. Drawing upon organic inspirations—hardy succulents, sunlit pines, richly patterned malachite—they developed greens that are both vibrant and versatile.





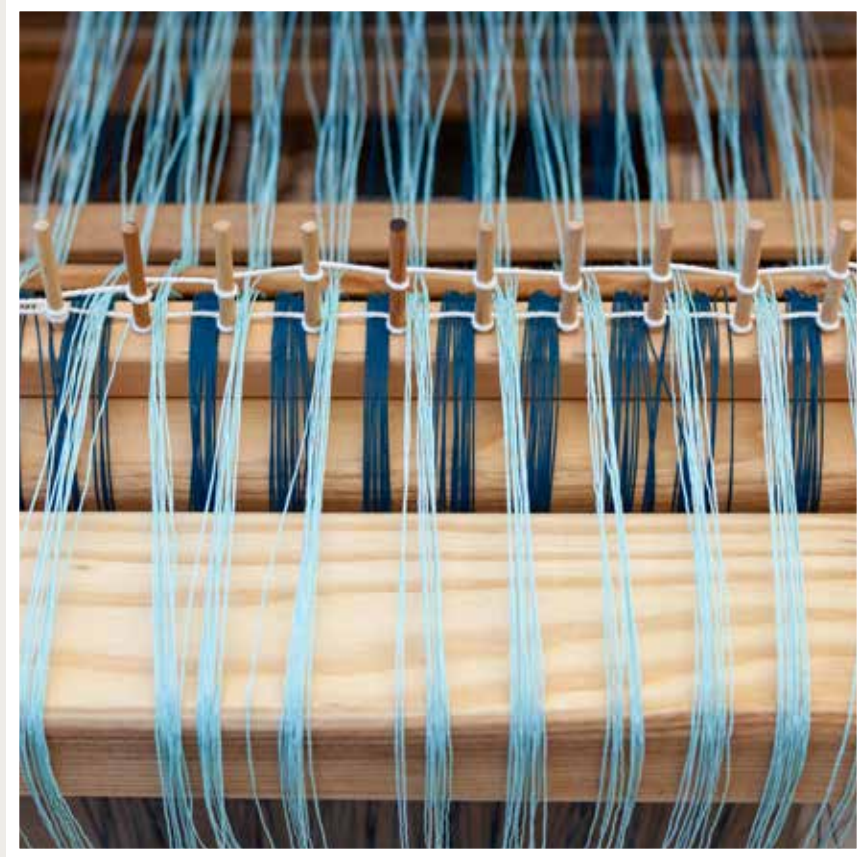




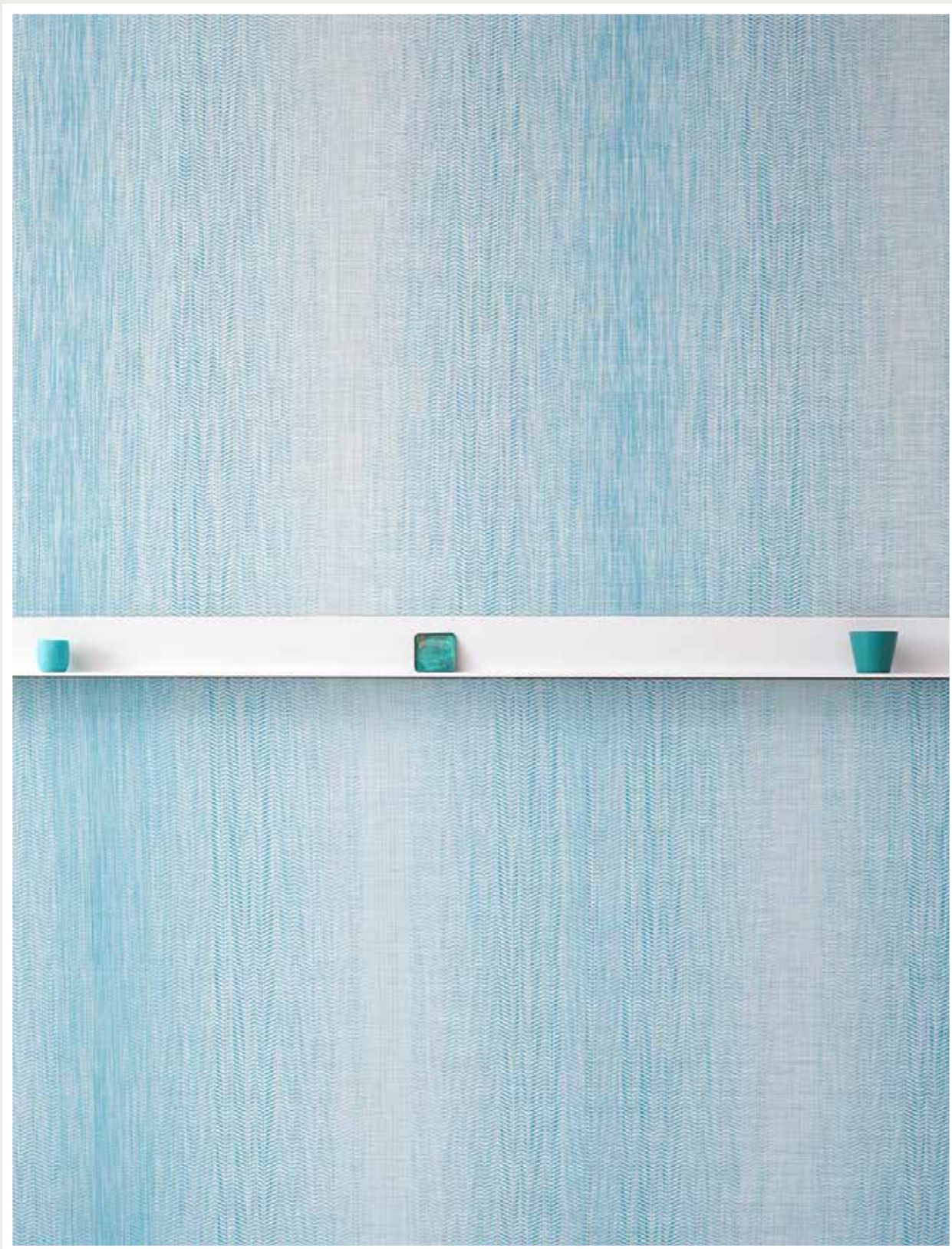


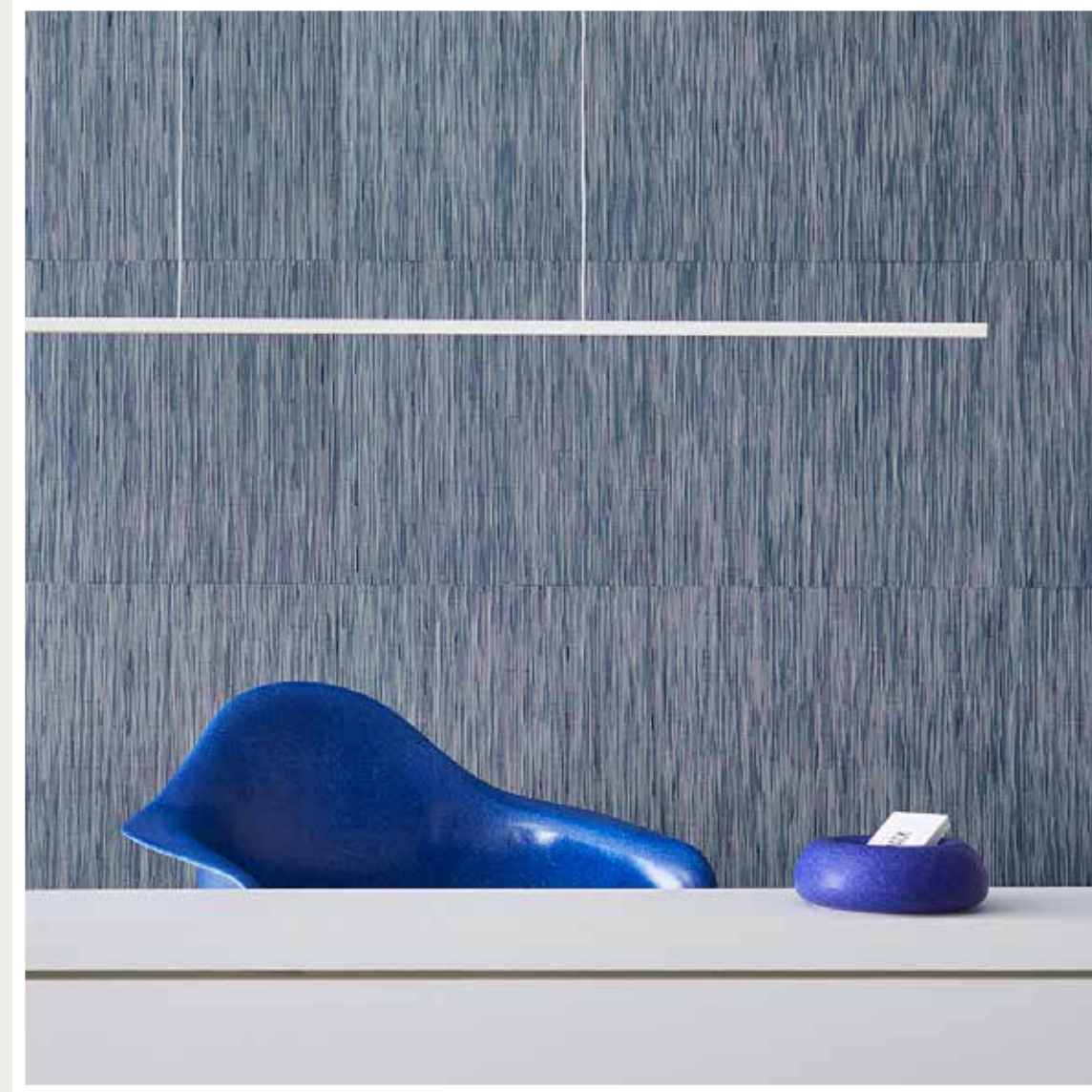
Out of the Blue

Aquatic hues sampled from sea plants, swimming pools, and Atlantic swells informed the creation of shade-shifting combinations of cool colors. Turquoise is reimagined in variegated geometries, while blue returns to its roots in classic cobalt and moody midnight.





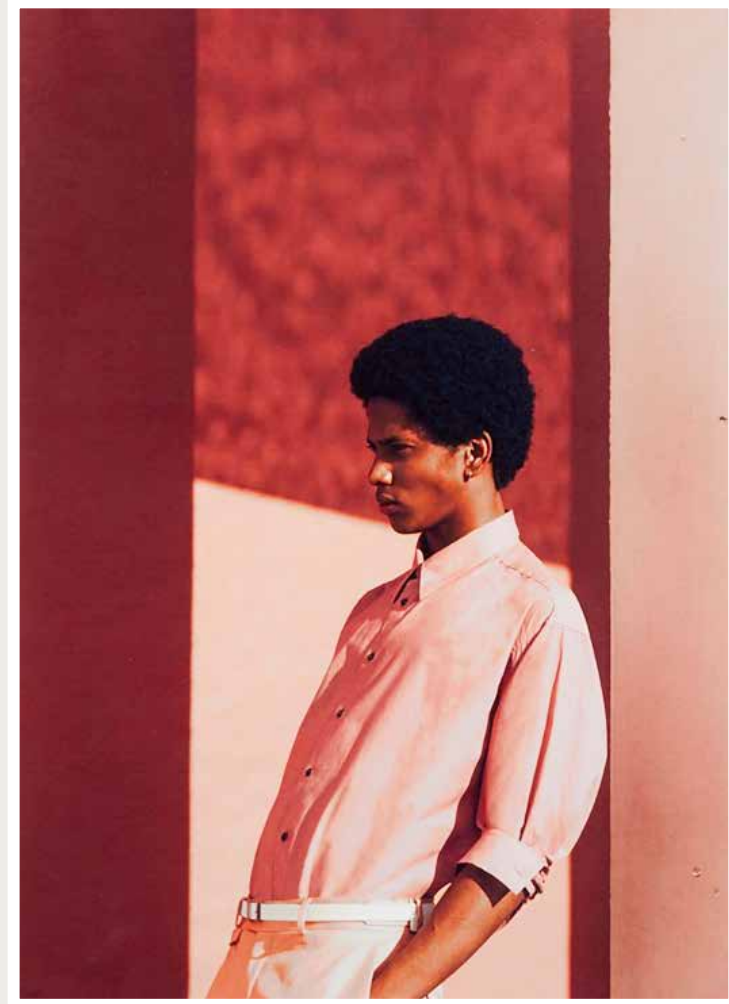
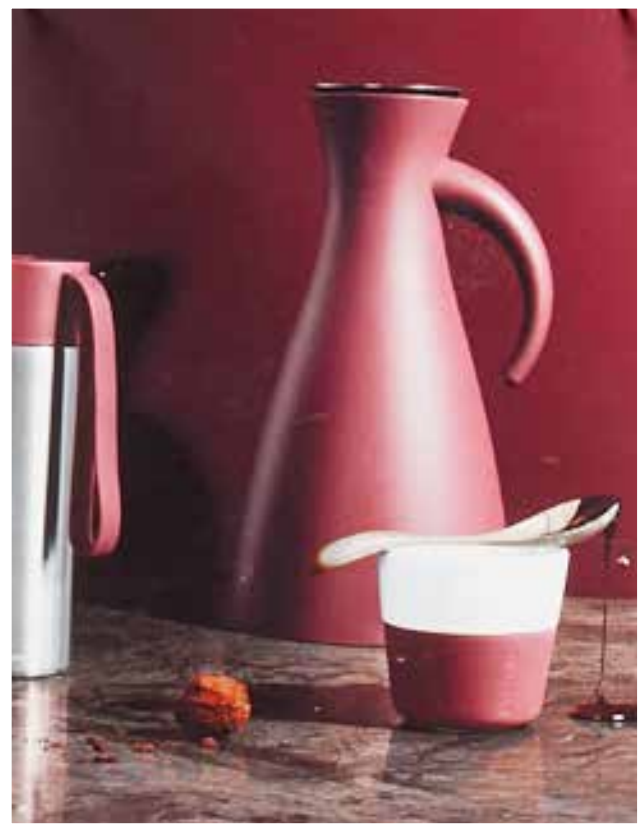












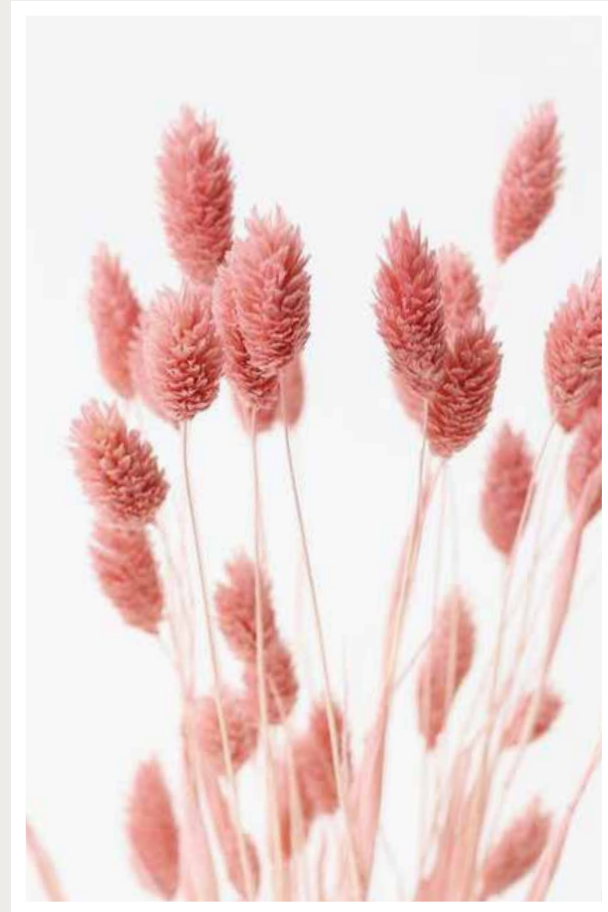
Real Reds

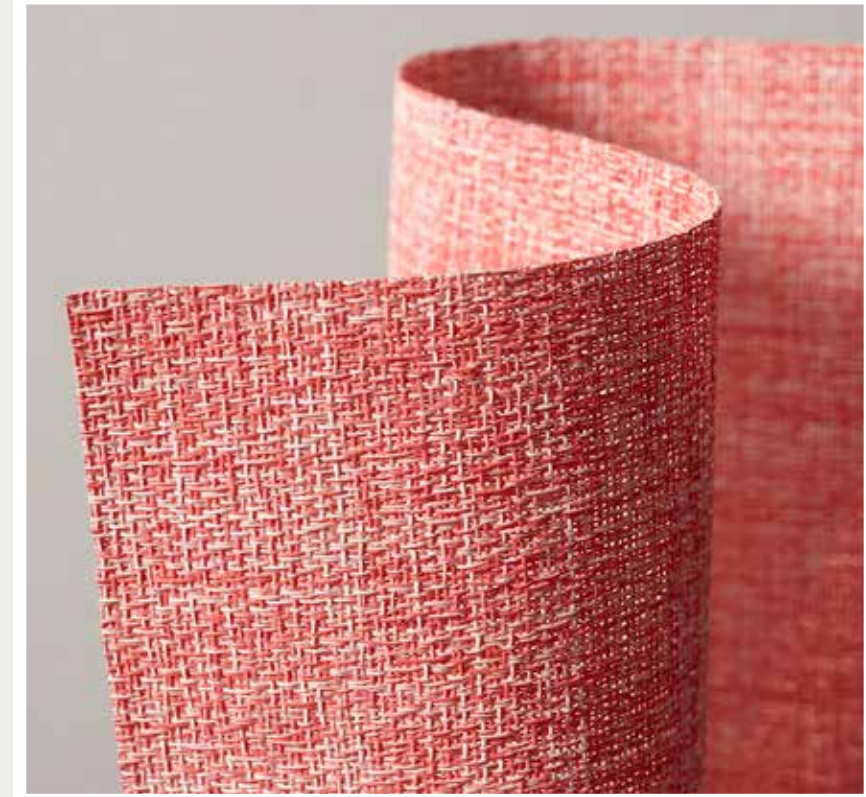
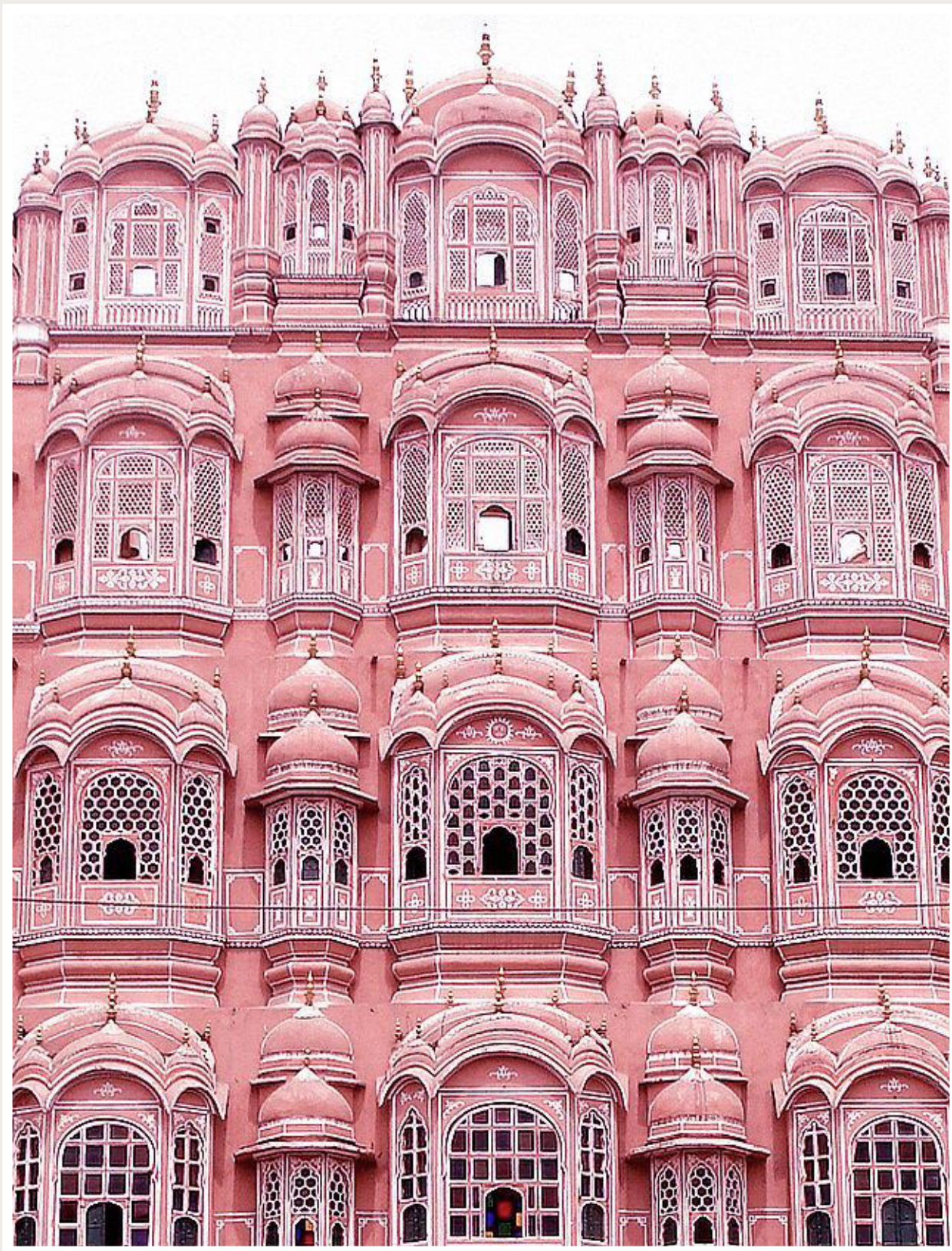


The Power of Pink

An exploration of red's softer side led to the development of warm, joyful hues inspired by precious coral and tropical fruits. Ranging from radiant to rosy, each color is placed in dialogue with white, allowing it to act as either a foundation or an accent.











New Neutrals

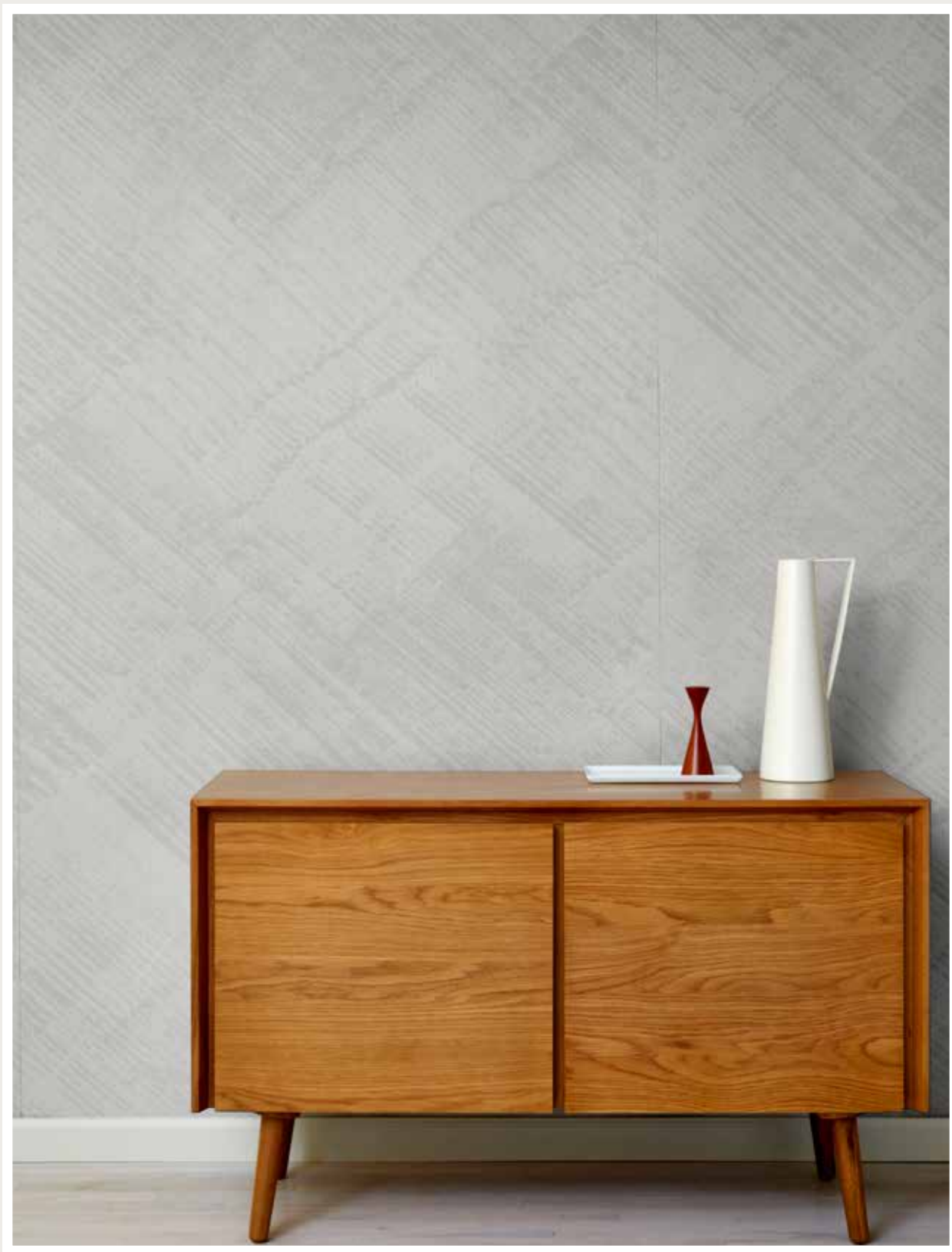

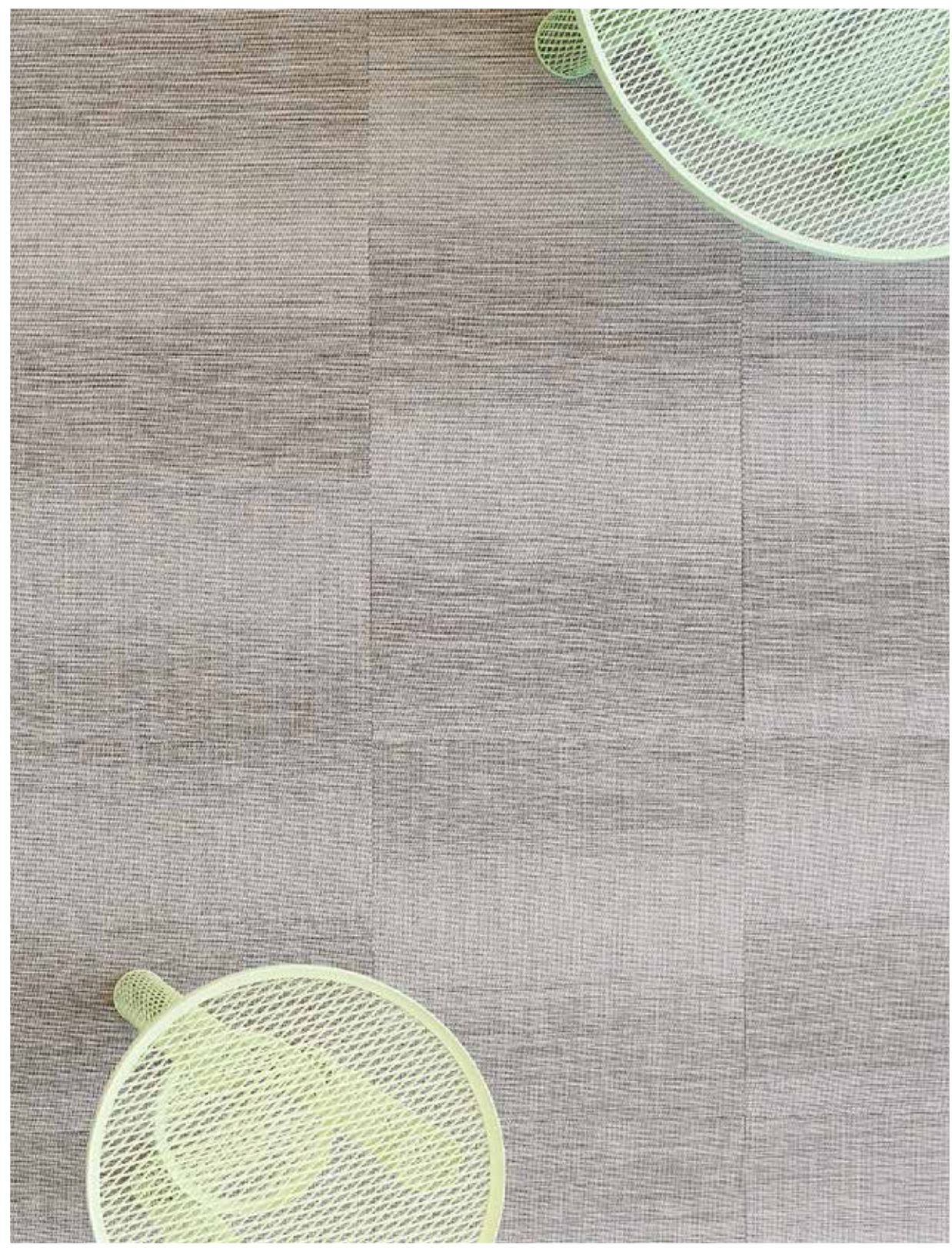




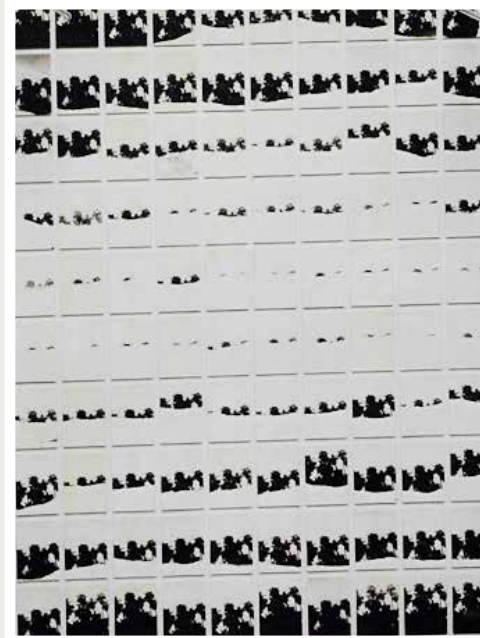












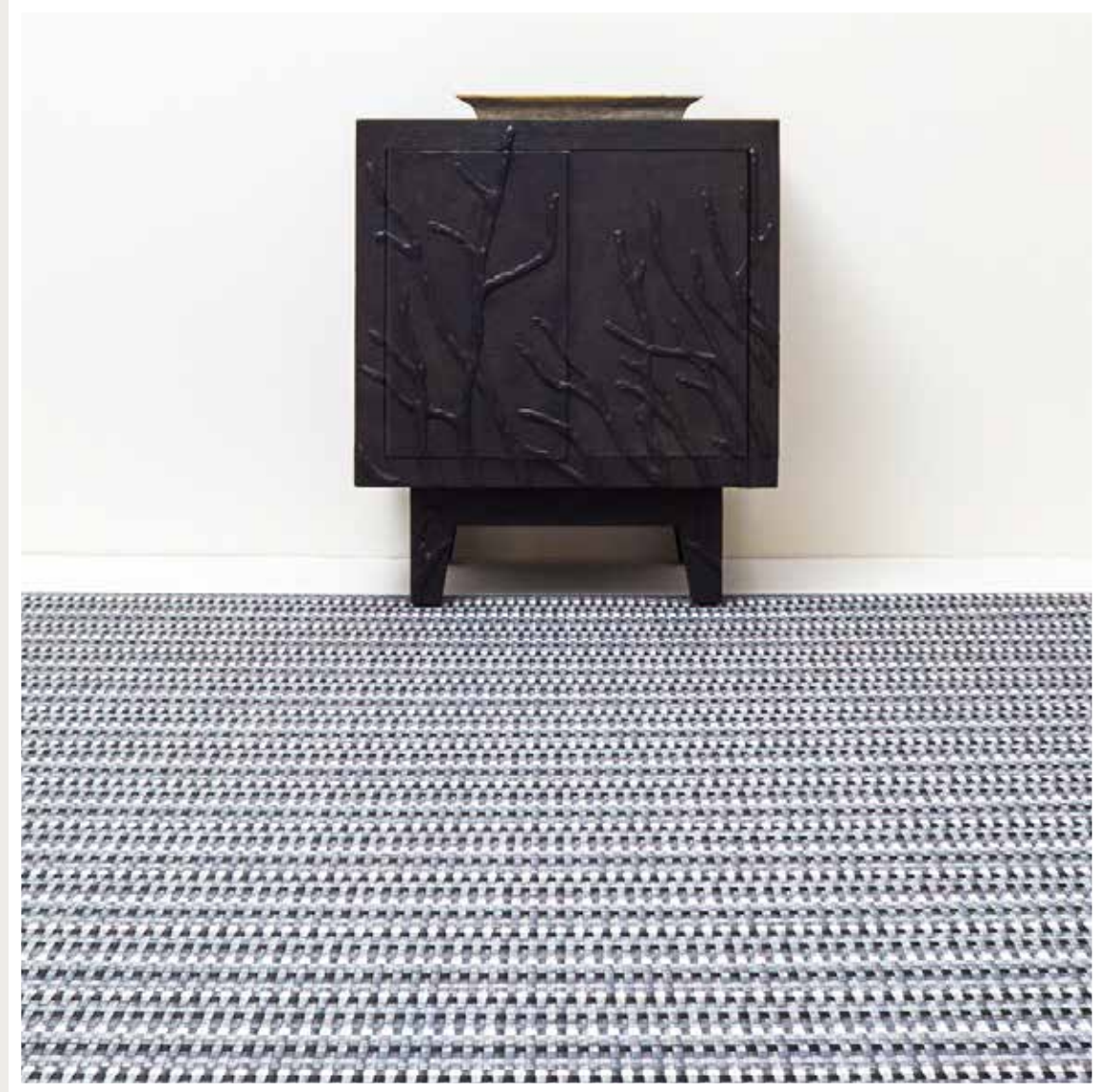
Mastering Monochrome
