Submissions are invited in the following areas that address design, development and delivery of passenger/client transport affordability, adaptability, accessibility and flexibility

- Social policy (e.g. NDIS, My Aged Care and Health etc.).
- New and innovative approaches to transport solutions across Australia.
- State and Federal legislation/policy impact on passenger/client transport.
- Engagement and communications with users.
- Opportunity for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people/communities to increase economic participation in the area of transport provision.
- Building Community capacity around development of local solutions.
- Transport innovations that can be applied/adapted across States and Territories.

#### **CONFERENCE ABSTRACT SUBMISSION**

- Abstracts must be submitted online by <u>5pm on Friday 20 December 2019</u> to <u>admin@natsic.com.au</u>.
- Abstracts must not be longer than 300 words.
- · Abstracts should be structured as follows: Background, Objectives, Applications and Conclusions.
- The title should not be longer than 20 words.
- If abbreviations or acronyms are used, they should be written out in full the first time they are used.
- Tables and graphs can be submitted with your abstract as an attached image document. Compatible formats are: gif, png, jpg, jpeg, tif, pdf. Please remember to insert the reference (Table 1, Figure 1, etc.) in the abstract.

# ACCEPTANCE AND NOTIFICATION OF SUCCESSFUL ABSTRACTS

Acceptance of abstracts into the conference program will be determined by the relevance, originality, clarity and overall quality of the submitted work by the NATSIC Executive. Notification of acceptance of abstracts will be advised by <u>3 February 2020</u>.

All presenters of accepted abstracts are required to register and attend the conference. NATSIC, as the conference organiser, reserves the right to withdraw abstracts if presenters have not registered for the 2020 National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Transport Conference, by 17 February 2020 (this will allow a suitable time frame for the production and finalisation of the conference program for circulation).
