How to Register Your Number on the Do Not Call Registry

Unwanted telemarketing calls can be a nuisance, intruding on your day and violating your privacy. The <u>Do Not Call Registry</u> offers a solution to opt-out of such calls. This article provides a brief guide on how to register your phone number.

Step 1

VISIT THE OFFICIAL WEBSITE

Go to the official Do Not Call Registry website (https://www.donotcall.gov/) managed by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC).

Step 2

ENTER YOUR PHONE NUMBER

Enter the phone number you wish to register. You can include both your home and mobile numbers.

Step 3

VERIFY YOUR IDENTITY

Verify your identity through a confirmation call, email, or text message as instructed on the website.

Step 4

CONFIRM REGISTRATION

Upon successful verification, your number will be registered indefinitely unless you choose to remove it. Telemarketers must consult the registry and avoid calling listed numbers.



Additional Tips

CHECK REGISTRATION

Verify if your number is already registered by entering it on the website.

REPORT VIOLATIONS

File a complaint with the FTC if you continue receiving calls after registration.

UPDATE INFORMATION

Register your new number if you change it.

Registering your number on the Do Not Call Registry is an easy way to protect your privacy and reduce unwanted telemarketing calls. Follow these steps to ensure your number is safeguarded.
