Before the September 25 event, there will be reviewers from both TAOG and ACOG District XI who will read and view the submissions (hence the earlier deadline for receipt of your work). Several of these reviewers will be at the virtual meeting to ask questions and comment on your work. We are hopeful that other ACOG and TAOG members as well as some medical students, other residents, residency and fellowship program directors, and practicing clinicians will also be present to enjoy the shorter, live presentations.

Following the completion of all the presentations and the question and answer sessions there will be a break followed by an evening social gathering and awards ceremony to allow for further social networking and announcement of winners. ***Of note, only submissions that include abstract, video, and participation in the live event will be qualified for awards. ***

This year the TAOG executive committee plans to offer a brief summary of written feedback to each resident by private communication on their project, abstract, presentations (video and virtual) a few weeks following the virtual symposium in hopes that this might be helpful for future submissions/presentations. We look forward to your submissions and participation. Your participation in this event does not prevent you from submitting the same research project to other events.

As usual each Texas residency can send only one submission. Thank you for your support and participation of the Dr. Ralph Anderson Texas Association of Obstetricians and Gynecologists Annual Resident Research Symposium.

Please submit your abstract, video submission, a photo, and the completed form no later than August 21, 2020 by 5 pm Texas time and make plans for the live, "virtual" event on September 25, 2020!
