



PICK UP & DROP OFF

Drop off for Youth Group will always be at Heritage Hall at First Methodist Church, 208 Pine Street. This building is across the street from the park and the main door is painted with a mosaic cross. Drop off for youth is at 5 DM



Drop off for In-Betweens is at Moore Hall at First Methodist Church, 208 Pine Street. This building is north of Heritage Hall and the main door is under the oak trees and faces the park. Drop off for In-Betweens is also at 5 PM. The In-Betweens will meet in the Side By Side classroom.



Pick up for both groups will be at the Christian Life Center (CLC) at 7 PM. The main door for the CLC faces the large parking lot on the west side of our church campus. Parents can enter the CLC and pick up In-Betweens from their classroom and youth from dinner in the CLC.



If your student drives his or herself to youth group, we will be asking them to begin parking in the CLC parking lot and walking over to Heritage Hall. That way we can see all students safely to their cars at the end of the night when it is dark.


