INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF YOUNG BEEKEEPERS 2026

HISTORY OF IMYB

The International Meeting of Young Beekeepers (IMYB) is the world's largest gathering dedicated to young people with a passion for beekeeping. First held in 2010 as a small initiative led by the Czech Republic, the event has since grown into a truly global celebration of bees, learning, and international friendship, welcoming participants from over 40 countries across Europe and beyond.

In July 2026, IMYB will be hosted in Northern Ireland for the first time.

Designed for young beekeepers aged 12 to 18, IMYB offers a unique fourday experience that combines friendly competition, cultural exchange, and unforgettable social experiences. Participants put their knowledge and practical skills to the test through a series of beekeeping challenges, while also building friendships, discovering new cultures, and often enjoying their first trip abroad without their parents.

To date, 13 IMYB meetings have taken place in countries including Austria, France, Germany, Slovenia, Slovakia, the UAE, and England, with each year welcoming more countries, more young people, and more international connections. Past participants have proudly represented national teams from Australia, China, South Africa, the USA, and almost every corner of Europe.

More than just a competition, IMYB is about inspiring the next generation of beekeepers, encouraging cross-cultural understanding, and nurturing global awareness of the vital role bees play in our ecosystems. This event is building a buzzing global community of young changemakers.

At its heart, IMYB is a celebration of shared passion, learning through experience, and a vision for a more connected, sustainable future - one young beekeeper at a time.

NORTHERN IRELAND EVENT OVERVIEW

4TH - 7TH JULY | BELFAST, NORTHERN IRELAND

In July 2026, Northern Ireland will proudly welcome young beekeepers from around the globe as it hosts the prestigious International Meeting of Young Beekeepers (IMYB) for the first time.

This unique event will bring together beekeepers aged 12–18 for an unforgettable programme of learning, competition, social elements and cultural exchange.

Each participating country will send a team of three young beekeepers, accompanied by two adult facilitators. All participants and facilitators will be hosted at Elms Village, Queen's University Belfast, creating a vibrant and supportive international community for the duration of the event.

The event will feature a spectacular opening ceremony at the iconic Titanic Belfast, with local media, dignitaries and event sponsors marking the official start of the meeting. The social and cultural programme will highlight the very best of Belfast and Northern Ireland, including a special tree-planting event at the Ulster Folk Museum - a symbolic nod to sustainability and growth.

The main competition will take place at the elegant Riddel Hall, where young beekeepers will take part in a series of practical tasks designed to test and showcase their skills. While the young competitors focus on their challenges, a parallel social programme will be offered for the accompanying adults, allowing them to enjoy the sights, culture, and hospitality of Northern Ireland.

The closing ceremony will be held at Belfast City Hall, where the coveted title of Beekeeper of the World will be awarded, and the ceremonial baton passed to the next host nation.

Every participant will receive a medal, along with branded merchandise, including backpacks and bee suits, to commemorate their IMYB experience in Northern Ireland.
