- Has your child had any medication to reduce a fever before coming to care?

 Child care rules still do not allow providers to care for children who have other signs of being sick such as diarrhea and vomiting within the past 24 hours. If we suspect your child has an illness of any kind, we will not allow your child to stay at school. If at any time while your child is at school

and they become ill for any reason you will be required to pick them up immediately.

If the answer is "yes" to any of the above questions your child may not stay at school today.
