GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

Varsity VBC takes pride in keeping the lines of communication as open as possible between our director, coaches, volunteers, players and parents. - **STEP 1**: Please contact your players coach via email (preferred) or by phone *after a cooling off period of* 24 *hours*.
- **STEP 2:** The coach will review the concern and contact the contacting party for follow-up. Every attempt will be made to resolve the issue at this level.
- **STEP 3**: If the contacting party feels the issue has not been resolved, the next step is to take the matter to the Club Director, Julissa Jones. If needed, a non-biased third party may be brought in to help resolve the matter.
