Tournament Information

Coaches, thank you for participating in the 2020 Boys Stockton Classic. We are at 36 teams this year, and hope to see it continue to grow!

Match Format

All matches will be rally scoring to 25, best 2 out of 3, third game rally scoring to 15, no cap. National Federation of State High School Association rules will apply. **The Libero may be used for all matches, still have 18 subs. Every team will play 4 matches, with the possibility of one team playing a 5th match at Lincoln HS. It will be structured in the form of a tourney bracket.

Warm-ups

5 minutes hitting each, with a one minute warning for serving to your own team **for everyone's first match (total 10 minutes)** (The first match and second match on every court.) After everyone's first match, it will be 3 minutes each on the net used however you would like (6 minutes).

Note: Warm-up times are subject to change in case of delays.

Officiating

The officiating duties will be covered by the NCOA.

Each team will be asked to provide 2 line judges (preferably players), an umpire, a scorekeeper, an official scorer, and a libero tracker (6 people total). It is preferred that the umpire (bottom official) is a coach.

Awards

Team plaques will be given to the champions, runner up. Individual t-shirts will be given to each site champion.

Hospitality Room

A hospitality room will be provided for all coaches and officials. The hospitality room will have breakfast items, juice, water, fruit, muffins, donuts through the morning play, and sandwiches, which will arrive around 11am. We will show all the coaches where the hospitality room is.

Snack Bar

A snack bar will be at both sites. No outside food allowed in the any of the facilities. Note: No coolers are allowed inside the gym area.

Seating

Please let your parents and coaches know there will be bleachers/chairs pulled out at each site. However, there will be 1 court at Edison that will need chairs, **parents are allowed to bring their own chairs in, but must have rubber bottoms on it or put a blanket underneath their chair.**

Coaches Meeting

There will be a coaches meeting in the main gym @ each site at 730am. You will meet the tournament director, receive a packet of information, officially check-in, and be able to ask questions at that time.

Parent Information

Each site will have a gate for entrance. Cost for spectators are \$10, \$5 for 12 and under. Only SJS Section Passes and Lifetime passes accepted. No league passes allowed.
