#### Warm-ups

5 minutes hitting each, with a one minute warning for serving to your own team **for everyone's first match (total 10 minutes)** (The first match and second match on every court. After everyone's first match, it will be 3 minutes each on the net used however you would like (6 minutes).

**Note:** Warm-up times are subject to change in case of delays.

### **Officiating**

The officiating duties will be covered by the NCOA.

Each team will be asked to provide 2 line judges (preferably players), an umpire, a scorekeeper, an official scorer, and a libero tracker (6 people total). It is *preferred* that the umpire (bottom official) is a coach.

#### Awards

Team plaques will be given to the champions, runner up at all sites. Individual championship shirts to the winning team.
