
"HELPING CHURCHES HELP PEOPLE"



## A Love Story

John and Grace (not their real names) and their three young boys moved to Ontario a few weeks ago having lost their jobs in Idaho. They were promised interviews at local businesses but after arriving found that the businesses were not hiring. They were staying in a motel for temporary housing and their money was running out. One of our partner churches told them to contact Love INC to see what assistance might be available while they continued to look for work. One of our trained volunteers took their call and began to hear their story. We followed up with references, confirmed their need, and began to pray and work to find ways to help them. Having observed their tenacity in seeking employment (which they both did achieve quickly) we supported them by helping pay for their lodging until they were able to get their first paychecks. With support from our partner churches we were able to meet their immediate needs and encouraged them to get connected with the church. They did! They report that the church has been very gracious towards them and has welcomed them in. Grace told us that their boys love attending! They expressed to us how grateful they are for the help they have been given and are on their way to becoming self-sustaining members of the community. They have a ways to go, but your partnership and prayers have helped them take positive steps.
