City Council will be considering rule changes which would allow **Sixplex** homes to be built in local neighbourhoods everywhere without requiring additional planning approvals or community input. Only a building permit would be needed.

Sixplexes are detached homes which contain up to six independent residential apartment units inside.

These are in addition to the effects of related upcoming or completed rule changes including: **fourplexes**, **parking**, **retail in neighbourhoods**, **apartments & townhouses on major streets**, **mid-rise on avenues**, development **near transit**, and **garden suites**.
