The Gospel On The Move

"Acts picks up where Luke's Gospel ends—tracing the explosive, unstoppable spread of the gospel from a small upper room in Jerusalem to the heart of the Roman Empire.

It follows the Holy Spirit's mission through ordinary people: Peter, Stephen, Philip, and especially Paul, sent out from Antioch to proclaim Christ across Cyprus, Asia Minor, Greece, and beyond.

Along the way come riots, shipwrecks, prison cells, miraculous rescues, and courageous testimony before governors and kings—all carrying one unwavering message: nothing can stop the purposes of God. The book closes with Paul in Rome, still teaching "without hindrance" (Acts 28:31), a deliberately unfinished ending—because the mission continues through us.

Acts was likely written around a.d. 62–64.

Join us for "UNHINDERED: The Gospel on the Move," a 9-week journey through Acts 13–28, using this 61-day daily reading plan to walk through it together.
