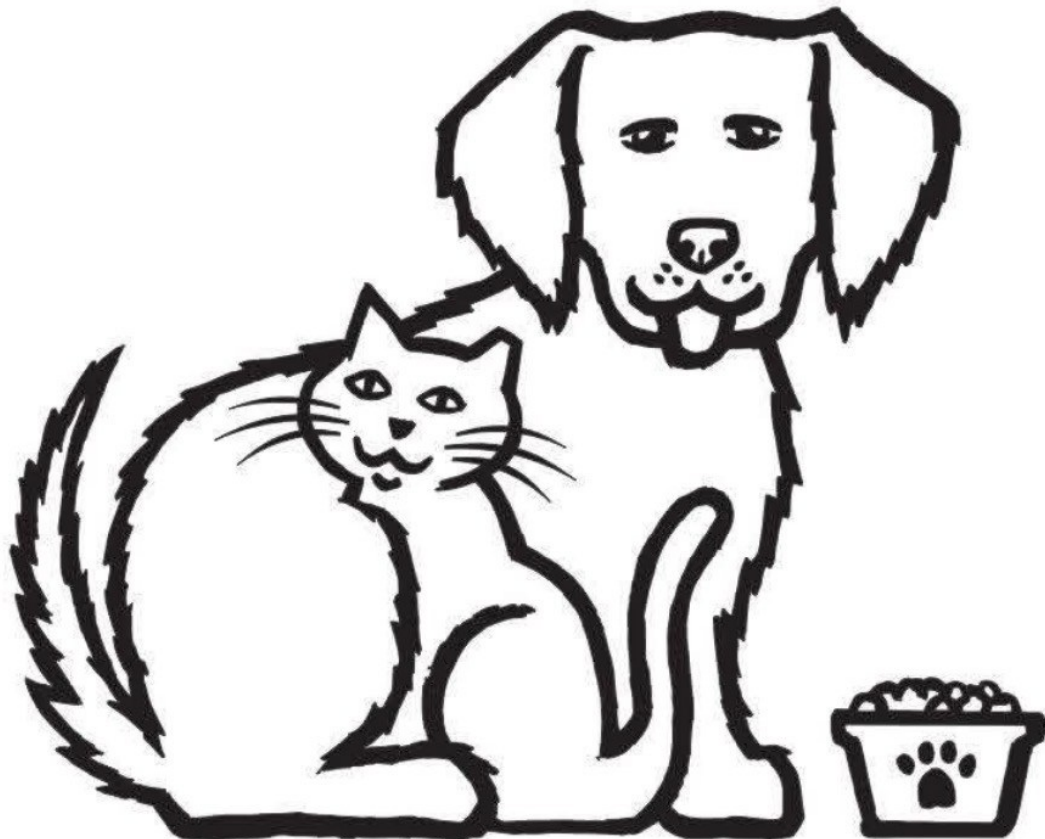

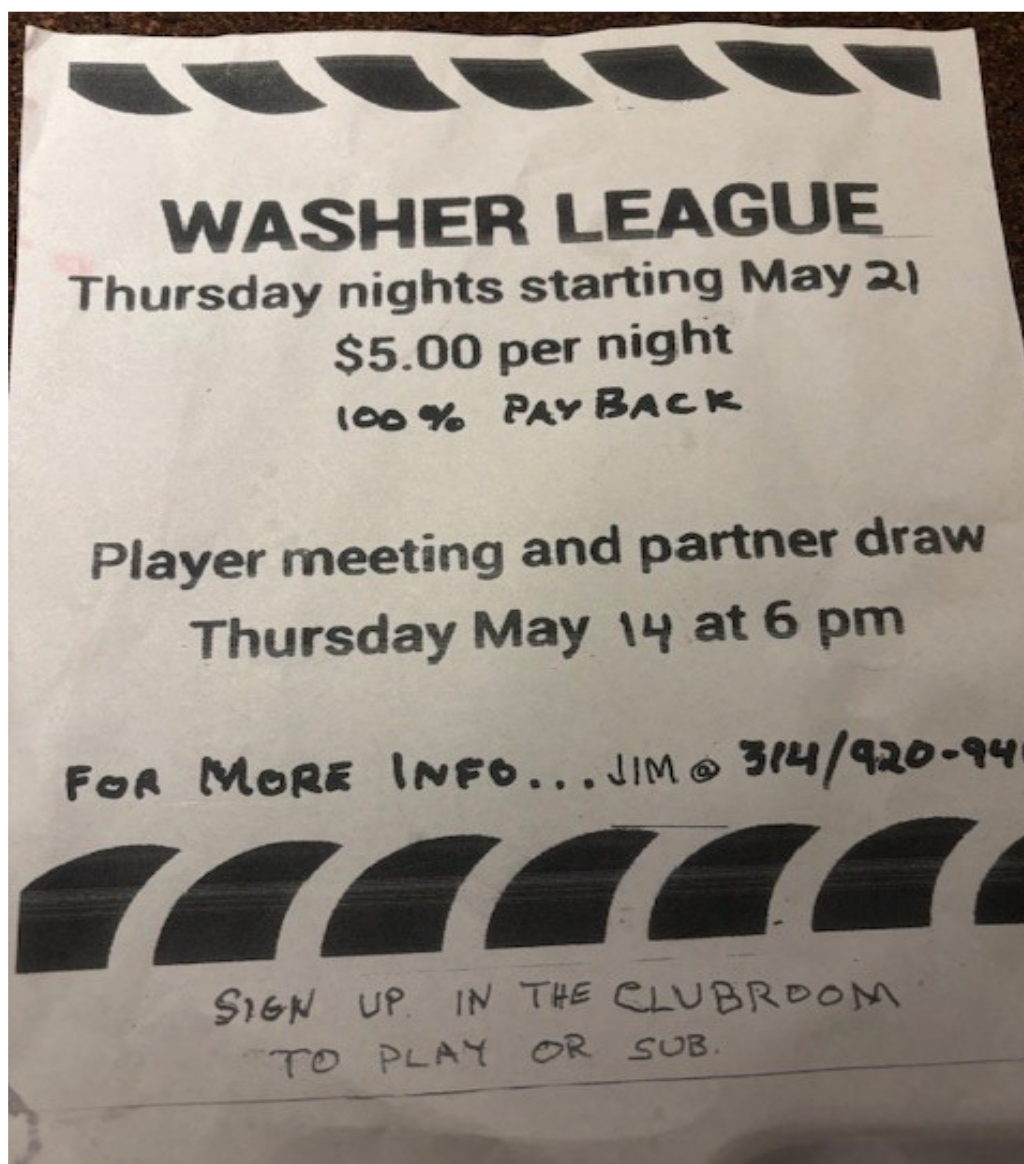
If you experience F O M O...There still is time to sign up!!

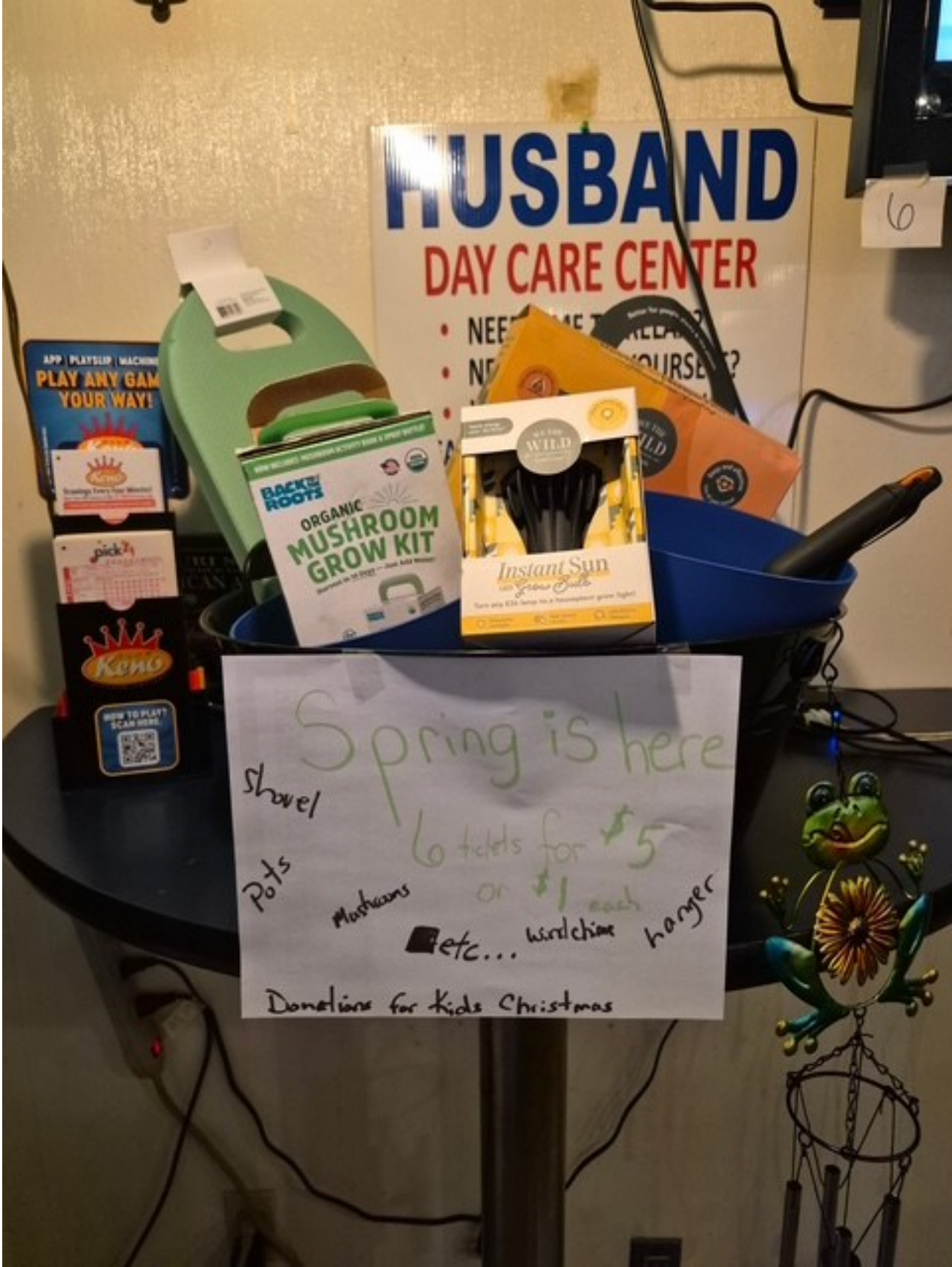

URBAN HABITAT

We have been following the Missouri Conservation Department's recommendations to eradicate the invasive weeds on the back parking lot grassy area and replace them with native plants. This project will help support monarch butterflies and pollinating bees, both of which are dying at an alarming rate. Our agent, Liam Connolly, has been extremely helpful throughout this process. At this stage, the heavy brush has been removed and the majority of the spring growth has been killed. We are planning to burn off the area on Sunday, May 3rd, at 1:00 p.m. Any volunteer help would be greatly appreciated. If you are able to join us, please bring a rake or a blower; we may also need some diesel fuel. Please come help beautify your club and give Mother Nature a helping hand at the same time.
