

Thank you all again for a great exhibit and a great show! Judy again pulled off a very well organized and smooth running Orchid Quest!

The set up with 100 orchid plants went quite smoothly with Terri checking members' plants in, Audrey, Meg, Lynn, Amy, and myself putting on the labels that Rich made and then putting on the registration labels. Thanks to all of the members for getting their plants to Alliant by 11 AM!!

There were minimal corrections and the great registration team (Gary and Steve) was able to get the registration labels to us by 11:30 so we could start placing the plants. Terri and Sue had the skeleton of the plant stands set up before Lynn was able to drill the hooks into her neat windows which Gary so skillfully hung. Then dynamo Amy set up the color flow from our focal point of Robert's Lc. Bowri-Alvida 'Pink Lady' which was joined by our abundant selection of nicely grown pink flowering orchids! (Of course we were not the only ones impressed with Robert's plant for it was pulled for AOS judging!) Amy orchestrated the flow with back-up from Lynn and Sue. After about 5-6 hours with Amy, Lynn, and Sue placing plants, doing the finishing touches of tiling, and moss placement with Audrey's assistance, the exhibit was com-

pleted.

This year there is a new scoring and grading of exhibits. There is as always a first place, and Best of Class award for the exhibits, which ours did receive. Now there is an AOS award, and because the exhibit is now graded on points, there is a chance for an AOS awarded certificate. Our exhibit this year received a first in class, Best in Class, AOS Best in Show and an AOS Silver certificate for scoring 85 points! Rich was told to take a photo of the exhibit for AOS, so we might see our exhibit in an AOS magazine!

We had 100 plants judged, having received 15 first place ribbons, one Best

of Class (Nancy T.), 11 second place ribbons, and 14 third place ribbons. Therefore with about 41% of the plants entered receiving ribbons!! Not bad at all!

I was especially impressed by the smooth, efficient team effort that helped take down the exhibit and organize the plants, moss, tiles, etc. for removal. Thanks so much for working so very well together! I think this goes for the whole show working very smoothly together under Judy's expert leadership!


