The room was filled with orchids for sale, orchid supplies and orchid novelties, and the public took advantage of that. The Marriott staff said they had never seen a convention have as long a line to get in as our attendee line was before the Saturday morning opening!

The displays were beautiful with orchids that were incredible. Thanks to all who sent plants to the OGG exhibit, we received the AOS award for best display (thanks Sue for your attention to detail!) I was really appreciative of everyone for their patience when the computer judging program needed more time before the judging started. Even with the late start, we still opened on time.

I had the opportunity to talk to nearly all of the vendors. They seemed pretty happy with the set-up and their sales. Some comments from attendees were, "Beautiful orchids! So enjoyed all the varieties. I had a very lovely afternoon!" and "Excellent speakers!"

Something else that made me smile: The printed orchid coloring pages were useful not only to entertain kids during the show, but grandparents took some home to use with grandchildren.

I heard the "Free Orchid with Membership" to the Orchid Guild was REALLY successful giving us an additional 15 members. Our February meeting with the topic of "Repotting Your Orchids" should be very popular. All these new members, plus our other members can BRING the orchids they want repotted and the experts will help. I am looking forward to that.

I don't have all the numbers from Orchid Quest sorted out yet, it will take a while. This I can give you. We had 756 admissions on Saturday with 192 using coupons of one sort or another.
