**PETITION FOR PRELIMINARY AND
PERMANENT INJUNCTION WITH RULE NISI**

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, come plaintiffs, in the above entitled and captioned matter, who for the purpose of this Petition, do respectfully represent:

1.

The plaintiffs are RONALD REMEDIES ("Ronnie") and ANDREA REMEDIES ("Andrea"), husband and wife, and major domiciliaries of Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, and reside at 9785 Nightingale Road, Shreveport, LA 71106.

2.

Made defendant herein is GEORGE ERIC HATFIELD ("Hatfield"), a person of the full age of majority and domiciled in Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, and resides at 10305 Ellerbe Road, Shreveport, Louisiana 71106.

3.

Hatfield is Constable in Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

4.

Ronnie acts on various parish and city boards, including, the Shreveport Fire and Police Municipal Civil Service Board, that interacts with law enforcement in Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

5.

Andrea has worked in the Insurance Industry for 10 years with the same company, and she has been admitted into an Agent program for that company.

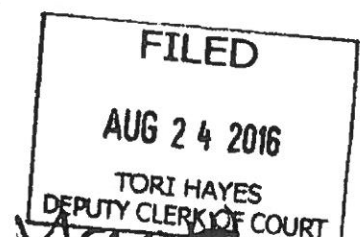
6.

Ronnie, Andrea and Hatfield are neighbors living approximately 100 yards apart.

7.

In recent months, Hatfield has been engaged in threatening behavior and harassment toward Ronnie, and Andrea, both individually and jointly.

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8.

On July 26, 2016, Ronnie and Andrea were at El Chico, 1513 E. Bert Kouns, Shreveport, Louisiana. Ronnie saw Hatfield from across the restaurant. Hatfield waited outside El Chico for Ronnie and his wife, Andrea, to leave the restaurant. As Ronnie and Andrea walked to their vehicle, Hatfield tried to start a fight with Ronnie and threatened bodily harm. Present was another Constable, Gene Pressly, who also threatened Ronnie.

9.

On July 27, 2016, Ronnie reported this incident to the Shreveport Police Department and an Offense Report, CAD #16129858, was issued. See **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto.

10.

On August 10, 2016 at 8:30 a.m., Ronnie was at a meeting of the Shreveport Fire and Police Municipal Civil Service Board, and at the meeting, Hatfield and another Constable, Gene Pressly, showed up in full uniform and Hatfield had a manila file. Hatfield was looking at Ronnie in a menacing fashion and pulled Lloyd Thompson, Board Chairman ("Thompson"), aside at a break. Hatfield asked to talk "about Remedies". Hatfield said "we have big problems with him [Ronnie] being on this board" pointing to the file. Thompson asked Hatfield if Hatfield wanted to come before the Board and Hatfield said "no", but he would "put it in writing". Ronnie is informed and believes that Hatfield has made no complaint in writing or otherwise, and is seeking to impugn Mr. Remedies' reputation by innuendo.

11.

Several months ago, Hatfield began interfering with work of Andrea. Hatfield called the agency where Andrea is employed and told his agent he felt uncomfortable leaving his business there as long as Andrea worked there. This message was interpreted as a request to terminate Andrea from her position with the company.

12.

Ronnie and Andrea fear that Hatfield will continue to harass, threaten bodily harm and interfere with their business and employment, for reasons unknown to Ronnie and Andrea.

13.

Ronnie and Andrea show that because Hatfield has continued a pattern in his actions they

are entitled to and seek to arrest Hatfield to prevent his conduct to them before irreparable injury, including, threatening bodily harm, are sustained.

14.

Plaintiffs further show that Hatfield has a history of violent behavior. According to the public records of the Shreveport City Court, Hatfield has been charged with two counts of simple battery. Citation issued against Hatfield on November 9, 1998 in Suit No. S8076351, Shreveport City Court charging him with simple battery. The deposition of this case was nolle pros. Citation issued against Hatfield on March 12, 2000 in Suit No. K2080892, Shreveport City Court, charging him again with simply battery. Hatfield was convicted and ordered to serve probation.

15.

Likewise, Mr. Hatfield has a documented history of threatening behavior and harassment of others, including members of his family. He has also engaged in behaviors very similar to that alleged above in the past, seeking to interfere with the employment, professional and civic relationships of others who have been unfortunate enough to be the subject of his obsessive focus.

16.

Finally, petitioner alleges that Mr. Hatfield has a history of disobeying court orders, having been held in contempt of court at least twice, which orders led to further inappropriate and threatening behavior by Mr. Hatfield, including ethical complaints against the judges and lawyers who were forced to allege and adjudicate the issues pertaining to his improper conduct.

17.

Plaintiffs, RONALD REMEDIES and ANDREA REMEDIES desire an Order of Protection Peace Bond issue in the form attached as **Exhibit "B"**.

WHEREFORE, plaintiffs, RONALD REMEDIES and ANDREA REMEDIES, PRAY that this Court issue its preliminary injunction for the pendency of these proceedings, and subsequently a permanent injunction, according to law and without bond, directed to defendant, GEORGE ERIC HATFIELD, enjoining, prohibiting and preventing defendant, Hatfield, from:

1. Abusing, harassing, stalking, assaulting, following, tracking, monitoring, or threatening RONALD REMEDIES and/or ANDREA REMEDIES. This prohibition includes the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury;

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2. Any contact with RONALD REMEDIES or ANDREA REMEDIES personally, through a third party, or via public posting, by any means, including written, telephone, or electronic (text, email, messaging or social media) communication;
3. Going within one hundred yards of RONALD REMEDIES or ANDREA REMEDIES;
4. Contacting any family member of RONALD REMEDIES or ANDREA REMEDIES personally, through third party, or via public posting, by any means, including written, telephone, or electronic (text, email, messaging, or social media) communication;
5. Going within one hundred (100) yards of the residence or household of RONALD REMEDIES or ANDREA REMEDIES;
6. Going to the place of employment of RONALD REMEDIES or ANDREA REMEDIES; and
7. Communicating with any employer or business associate of RONALD REMEDIES or ANDREA REMEDIES requesting or suggesting they cease or modify the business or employment arrangement with RONALD REMEDIES or ANDREA REMEDIES.





ON 7-27-16 I MADE CONTACT WITH RONALD REMEDIES WHO STATED HE WAS AT EL CHICOS 1513 E BERT KOUNS EATING WITH HIS WIFE. MR. REMEDIES STATED HE WALKED ERIC HATFIELD ACROSS THE RESTAURANT. MR. REMEDIES STATED HE LEFT THE EL CHICOS AND AS HE WALKED TO HIS VEHICLE ERIC HATFIELD SAID "TAKE ME TO (UNREADABLE)" REMEDIES STATED HE SAID BACK "YA WHATEVER" AND CONTINUED TO HIS VEHICLE. MR.
