MISSION MOMENTS APRIL, 2023

This month is the celebration of Easter and the glorious Resurrection of Christ our Savior. As we celebrate that wonderful event that defines Christianity, I pray all of us will have our Spiritual beings resurrected. Tim Tennent, President of Asbury Theological Seminary, wrote the book, *Keeping The Main Thing*. His perspective on the parable of the Good Samaritan reminded me of our need to be "Resurrected Christians". Read the Parable in Luke

10:25-37 and you'll see the cast of characters. Paraphrasing, we see the wounded man lying---stripped, beaten, robbed and half dead. Fast forward and the Priest walks by in too much of a hurry and focused on his own agenda, he hears the groans but quickly moves on. Another traveler, the Levite, gives a look and he too passes by on the other side fully dead to the one in need. It's not till the Samaritan comes along that the wounded man is helped. The question is, have we so ordered our lives as to avoid the possibility of contact with pain and suffering. We say, "oh my, I have my own pain and suffering and needs". Yet Jesus knows each individual's needs and still He calls us to help the poor and the wounded. Our mission's offerings go to relieve the suffering outside ourselves. Let's have a "resurrected heart" for the hurting world beyond ourselves as we look to this joyous Easter celebration.

Our March Mission focus was Noah Project and \$65 was received for the homeless that are served by Noah Project at Central UMC.
