PASTOR'S PONDERINGS...

Hold on! Here we go into another new year! As I head into retirement in June, I am being hit with "this is the last time I will be doing_____". Some of those things are sad to think about but others are a "yahoo!" It will be a year of change for several, if not all, of us. It is true that there is still a shortage of pastors in the UMC. Some different configurations may be happening or the churches may be expected to do some things they didn't before. Some pastors have returned from retirement to pastor churches and many have not. District Superintendents have assigned some people to churches who have not completed their seminary schooling. Local pastors are still greatly needed to pastor churches. One thing is sure, things will change every day.

I recently read these words about change written by Susy Alexandre...Change can often run parallel to the seasons. 
