## MMA Thursday, March 27 Program

Bek Campbell, a 23-year-old senior at the University of Central Missouri, pursuing a degree in Studio Art with a focus on Illustration, will present the program for the Thursday, March 27 meeting of Mid-Missouri Artists in the Arts and Crafts room of the Warrensburg Community Center beginning at 6:30 p.m.

Bek's program will focus on drawing the human form using charcoal, with an emphasis on structure, form, and shading. Working from a live model, participants will develop/practice foundational skills by learning to quickly sketch the skeletal framework before refining the figure with contour and wrapping lines. Participants will then explore tech-

Bek specializes in illustration, watercolor, and charcoal, developing a personal style that blends figure drawing with influences from surrealism and expressionism. She has created album covers for various musicians and designed shirts, logos, and stickers for companies such as Midwest Pool Management, Warrensburg Parks and Recreation, and CagelQ. She also contributed to the creative process for stickers commissioned by the 476th Fighter Wing at Moody AFB in Valdosta. In addition

to client work, she has led watercolor workshops at the Warrensburg Community Center, sharing her skills with the local community.

Now in the final stages of her college career, Bek aspires to become a concept and storyboard artist for animation studios such as Cartoon Network or Fortiche Productions, where she hopes to bring her surreal and expressive artistic vision to life.
