Rebecca enjoys using a variety of materials and techniques in creating collage art. A favorite material is altered papers made from old National Geographic magazines using Citrasolv. Creating these papers needs to be done outside, so we won't be doing that in the program. An instruction sheet will provide information on how to create the altered papers.

A selection of altered papers will be provided for each person and information given on tearing techniques and how to apply to surfaces. Each person will create a 4 x 6 collage.

Materials to bring: 3-4 paper towel sheets, small brush for applying acrylic gel, small container for water. Shapes you might want to use—animals, birds, geometrics. Fine point permanent Sharpies for those who might want to draw on their collage. Small scissors.
