Program: The Art of Drawing Birds by Susan Sanders.

I started with watercolor approximately 10 years ago. I had always wanted to learn this art form and my daughter in law gave me lessons for Christmas from the Kansas City Art Institute. Two years later I decided to take online lessons from Bonnie Snowden for a year. I enrolled in her program and followed live demonstrations and recorded demonstrations on everything colored pencil from wildlife to flowers to portraits.



I am self taught in pastels. Once you

learn proper techniques in colored pencil you can apply the same for pastels with a few exceptions. I have sold my work online, I have it displayed and for sale at Gallery Three in Clinton and now have my art for sale at The Asbury House in Higginsville.

I plan a presentation with colored pencil work online a female Cardinal which I will bring some sample paper for anyone that wants to get some experience with it. There would not be time to start and complete the whole bird portrait. but I intend to demonstrate enough to make everyone feel comfortable if they wanted to pursue this art form. I only use Pastelmat and Polychromos pencils for the best results.

Those attending may want to bring assorted pencils to practice with—white, greys, reds, tans, black. All will be provided a sketch to work from.
