For her program, she says "The intent is to create a miniature work of art by layering and glueing very thin torn or cut pieces of mulberry paper onto watercolor paper."

What you need to bring:

Small brushes to apply glue

Elmer's Glue

Water container

Small container for glue

Scissors

Tweezers

Photos or ideas to work from

Any interesting paper you might like to incorporate into your collage Small sheet of matboard or cardboard to use as a work surface

Shirley will provide the watercolor paper (size 4 x 6 inches); this will be a postcard show! Shirley will provide the colored unryu (mulberry paper).



Whiteman Air Force Base is hosting a competitive art exhibition. All local artists are invited to submit 1 artwork that reflects "Resiliency: Bravery, Determination & Grit in Daily Life." This exhibition offers an opportunity for established and emerging artists to display art at Whiteman Air Force Base. Please include an artistic statement demonstrating how your work connects to the themes. The art will be on display 11/8-11/18/2025 in the Learning Commons (511 Spirit Blvd. Bldg. 515, Whiteman AFB, MO 65305 Second Floor). Cash prizes will be awarded in each of the following categories: 14 to 17 years old, 18+ Age, Current Service Members. Cash prizes in each category will be 1st Place \$150.00, 2nd Place \$100.00, and 3rd-\$50.00. There will be one overall winner of BEST in Show (\$500.00). Winners will also be shared in multiple media locations. FREE TO PARTICIPATE - NO ENTRY FEE

All artwork must be ready to display. If framed, the frames must have wire or sawtooth hanging hardware attached. Plexi glass is preferred for frames. All artwork must be on display for the duration of the exhibition.

Maximum size of artworks

2-Dimensional Artwork: The longest dimension must be 35" or less and must weigh less than 10 pounds 3-Dimensional Artwork: Must have a footprint of no more than 24" x 24" and must be no taller than 36". Must weigh less than 25 lbs.

Eligibility: 14 – 17ys. Old, 18+ Age, Current and Prior Service Members

State/Location: Missouri, Whiteman Air Force Base

Entry Deadline: Preregister submissions by 10/24 midnight by scanning the QR code. In person registration will be available at drop off. A release statement will need to be signed for each piece.

Artwork drop-off: October 31st between 10am-12pm and November 1st, between 1pm and 3pm

Artwork pickup dates: Friday, November 21 between 10 am-12 pm and 4 pm-6 pm
