## Prior Lake City Ordinances

Did you know Prior Lake has ordinances on where and when you could ride within city limits? When I was talking with a reporter from the Southwest Publishing this past week, he was very surprised to hear this as he was unaware. I even talked with some PLSA Members recently and they too did not know of any ordinances. This is one the first things that we talk about to our youth during the recent snowmobile training event just held. You as a snowmobiler are responsible for knowing not only state laws, but local ordinances on snowmobile operation. The hard part is that in Scott County, Prior Lake, Savage and Shakopee all have different and sometimes conflicting ordinances. As an example, in Prior Lake, you can only ride on the trails. If you live off a trail and want to get to the trail on the snowmobile you are required to ride on the right most side of the street at no greater than 10 mph. You cannot ride on boulevards, across people's front yards, through parks, etc. In Savage you can ride in a right of way directly from your home to the trail. If you live in Savage, please consider and be respectful of the property owners in crossing their driveway as many have landscaping and other obstacles in the ROW.

### SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE STRICTLY ENFORCED



- ❖ Speed Limit is 10 mph on local streets
- ❖ Snowmobile hours: Sunday to Thursday 7 a.m. – 11 p.m.  
Friday and Saturday 7 a.m. – 2 a.m.
- ❖ Snowmobiles are PROHIBITED on Main Avenue and CR 21 West of Hwy. 13
- ❖ Snowmobiles are PROHIBITED on any sidewalk or trail unless designated for snowmobiling

## Fun






## Youth Snowmobile Training


