Please respond if you'd like to nominate someone, and it is ok to nominate yourself.

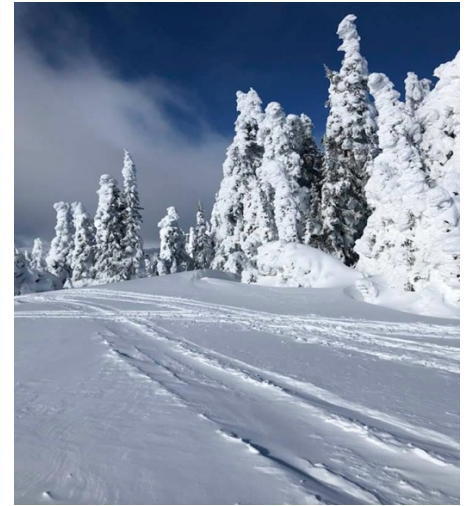
Adopt A Highway
