



# **Price & Policies**

**Effective Sept. 1, 2025**

**Private Riding Lessons:** Includes once per week lesson slot, *45-60 minutes*.

**Monthly Tuition \$240**

Single lesson \$70

**Group/Semi-Private Riding Lessons:** Includes once per week lesson slot, *60 minutes*.

**Monthly Tuition \$160**

Single lesson \$45

**Tiny Tots (4-7 years old) Lessons:** Includes once per week lesson slot, *30 minutes*.

**Monthly Tuition \$125**

Single Lesson \$35

## **Travel Fees:**

With Trailer \$2.50 per mile one-way. Paid to whoever is transporting the horse.

Without Trailer \$1.50 per mile one-way.

**\*No refunds will be given for any reason.**

**Code of Conduct:** All students (& their guests) are expected to maintain sportsman like conduct, follow the rules & directions given by the instructors, and act in a calm, safe way around the horses. Students who are not able to meet the standards of behavior may have their lesson time cut short.

Parents, Please leave the coaching to the trainers! We must insist that parents/visitors Do Not attempt to help riders during the lesson. That includes grooming, leading, tacking up, mounting, coaching from the rail, etc. Parents who are interfering will kindly be asked to wait in the car.

**Student Progression:** All new students must start out with private lessons. Students will be invited to join group lessons and/or move up to more advanced levels as they develop the required skills for each stage.

**Dress Code:** Riding boots with a heel, long pants & a helmet are REQUIRED! Students who are not dressed appropriately will not be allowed to ride. We encourage all students to purchase their own ASTM/SEI certified helmet. Students/parents are responsible for fitting & adjusting their helmet properly.

**Weight Restrictions:** For the health & safety of our lesson horses, each horse has a pre-determined weight limit. If you weigh over 200# please inquire before booking to ensure that we have a horse available to suit your needs.

**Payment Options:** Electronic payments (debit or credit) will be enrolled in auto-pay. Your card will automatically be billed on the 1st of each month. Cash or check payments can be left in the drop box in the barn & are due on or before the 1st of each month. If a cash or check payment is not made by the 1st of the month the student will be billed & asked to enroll in auto-pay.

**Refunds/Cancellations:** No refunds will be given for any reason! Lessons must be cancelled at least 24 hours in advance in order to reschedule.

**Holidays:** Being on a tuition system that is based on a 4 week month allows us 4 extra weeks each year that will be closed for Holiday breaks.

Holiday closures for 2025 are \*tentatively\* scheduled as follows:

**Make Up Lessons/Sick Days/Bad Weather/Etc.:** Lessons must be cancelled with at least 24 hours notice to be eligible for scheduling a make up lesson. Make up lessons must be rescheduled for within 30 days.

In the event of inclement weather lessons will shift to the barn/classroom. In the event of extreme weather conditions lessons may be cancelled/rescheduled at the trainers discretion.

**Injury Provision:** In the event of an injury to a rider (with a Dr. note) or their horse (with a DVM. note) they will be allowed to carry forward the balance of the lessons they've already paid for to be scheduled and used within 90 days.

**Cancelling Your Lesson Slot:** If you would like to cancel your recurrent lesson slot you must notify us by the 21st of the month before. This gives us time to de-enroll your auto-pay and fill the spot for the next month.
