The perfect solution to costly repairs on the following.

- 1. Cracked, spalling, broken, or deteriorating concrete.
- 2. Reattaching broken or loose Handrails to concrete.
- 3. Repairing broken or cracked curbs.

4. Repairing holes and cracks in Brick, Pavers and Outdoor Ornamental fixtures such as Bird baths, ceramic vases and concrete statues.

5. Attaching anchor bolts or equipment. Our epoxy will hold Tapcons as well if not better than conventual concrete.

SURFACE PREPARATION: To obtain a strong, long-lasting bond with Countrypride's epoxy Masonry Repair mix the surface must be dry and free of all loose particles such as dirt, oil, fat, or other foreign matter. The surface should be swept or blown to remove fine particles of debris. Smooth concrete surfaces should be mechanically scarified to assist bonding. The surface area should be at 60 Degrees Fahrenheit or higher before applying the epoxy blend.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Each kit contains the proper amount of Resin and Hardener for the powder supplied. YOU MUST POUR THE ENTIRE BOTTLE OF PROVIDED RESIN & HARDENER INTO THE CONTAINER, AND BLEND WELL FOR 4 TO 5 MINITES USING A STIR STICK BEFORE ADDING ANY POWDER. Let the mixed liquids sit for approximately 2 to 3 minutes after blending for air bubbles to dissolve.

To achieve a blend that will pour out of the bucket and be self-leveling you can use approx. ½ of the provided powder blend. To obtain a thicker blend that will hold better on vertical applications you will use close to, or the full amount of powder supplied.

When blending colors for the color matching you desire

- 1. Mix the full contents of Resin and Hardener in bucket as suggested.
- 2. Mix the powder blend with the liquid Resin till you reach the consistency you desire.
- 3. Using just a small pinch of the base colorant you are looking for and blend that till it is well mixed and continue to add colors at only small pinches at a time till you get the color you are looking for.

Depending on surrounding temperatures you will have a work time of 15 to 45 minutes.

A four-pound unit will cover a 4"x4"x2" deep area when utilizing a full bag of the provided powder blend. Thinner mixes result in reduced coverage area.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: CRACK REPAIR: Using a crack chaser blade cut a small V groove into the crack and blow out with an air blower or brush. If doing a vertical repair, you can first spray the area with adhesive and starting at the bottom as you fill the crack cover with Duct tape and work your way slowly up the wall. On horizontal repairs you can mix thinner and pour mix into the crack and allow it to self-level.

This product BONDS TO ALL SURFACES EXCLUDING SMOOTH PLASTIC, DUCT TAPE AND PLEXI-GLASS. When using anything else as a form you must first cover the area of the form that will make contact with the epoxy with duct tape. NOTE: Spray the form with adhesive and place the duct tape on the form with the sticky side out.

Countrypride's epoxy repair will cure in 4 to 6 hours at normal room temperature. It is recommended heavy traffic be kept off repaired areas for 24 hours. Outdoor applications should be covered or shaded from direct sunlight in extreme outdoor temperatures to prevent blistering.

SAFETY AND PRECAUTIONS: This product should be stored in an environment that is at least 70 degrees Fahrenheit, and BE KEPT OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Provided usage instructions need to be read prior to attempting to mix or apply.
