Dear Friends,

On Maundy Thursday, April 6, 2023 at 7 pm in the Large Hall, we will be celebrating the Passover as it was celebrated by Jesus with his disciples. Records are sketchy in some places, but the majority of aspects of the evening are authentic for that time.

We will not eat gifilta fish, have a boiled egg or a bare lamb shank bone on our plates, since this practice does not date back to the time of Jesus.

The meal itself will be a simple tasting of: lettuce dipped in vinegar, lamb, unleavened bread, Charoseth, and wine. The wine used was red and warm as was the custom, we will be using warm grape juice. Be sure to eat your supper before you come. RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED. The Passover was a festive occasion a celebration of the nation's release from Egyptian bondage.

As we replicate what the Jews of Palestine did at the time of Jesus, try to reflect on what may have been going through the disciples' minds as well as our Lord's, as we partake of that last Passover before his death.

This was to be a time of total relaxation. So, relax and prepare to have a good time!




Sanctuary Flowers



As of February 17, we have received 29 pledges which total \$3245. We had four expenses totaling \$469.27. The expenses included supplies for the P.A.D.s Project, Valentine and Easter cards for the home bound, food/supplies for Memorials, and an Honorarium for our January speaker.

Nestled on the corner of Vintage and Long Pond Road in Greece, our residents and their families can enjoy a lovely treed lot alongside a flowing stream, providing a peaceful, tranquil setting. There is no charge to come to Journey Home. They survive solely on donations, memorials, and fundraisers.
