SHIPMATES: The Saturday, March 12 meeting with the U.S. Customs and Border Control with Agent Steve Wasser has been canceled.

LENTEN STUDY: Beginning March 9, 2022, Dr. Spratt will explore Dante's Inferno. Dante's Inferno is the first part of Dante Alighieri's epic poem La divina commedia, or The Divine Comedy. Virgil the poet leads Dante into hell. Virgil guides Dante through the Nine Circles of Hell. In particular, Dante's Inferno is about the eternal fates

of villains of historical and literary renown. It examines the vices of human nature and ramifications of tragedy. The class will run every Wednesday for five weeks (March 9th, March 16th, March 23rd, March 30th and April 6th) from 7:00 pm to 7:30 pm on Zoom.

BUDGET TASK FORCE: As discussed at the Annual Congregational Meeting, we have a budget shortfall that requires using the General Endowment Fund to balance the budget. Our income has steadily declined year over year while expenses increase. This is not a sustainable way to operate. To address this issue, Session approved the formation of a task force to study the long term trends and propose ways to bring income and expenses into balance. PER CAPITA: This is a reminder to pay the per capita assessment for 2022. Per capita is the dues we pay to Presbytery, Synod, and General Assembly to help fund their operations and cover the services they provide us. The amount this year is \$35.58 for each member of the congregation. The amount is printed on the offering envelope box. If you don't make your contribution, Bethany will end up paying for your share using funds that could be used elsewhere in the budget. Thank you to those who have already made their payment!
