
BPWC= Bethany Presbyterian Women in the Congregation MINO = Mothers In Need of Others Project URGE = URGE!

During the month of November, BPWC needs your assistance for MINO, a program of Project URGE. Mothers in Need of Others (MINO for short) works with 145 shelters, churches, healthcare facilities and other agencies in our area to meet the needs of mothers and their infants. They run a Resource Room that collects supplies that go to these agencies and can also be accessed by case workers to obtain supplies for their individual clients.

BPWC = collecting individually wrapped tampons, maxi pads, pantiliners, and monetary donations in the month of November. There will be a decorated box in the narthex for the sanitary items.

Stephen Ministry




