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INT. NUTMUG COFFEE SHOP - BUSHWICK - DAY

A minimalist hipster vibe. A bearded Bushwick-er, LUKA, (20s) in a beanie at the register. A silent barista behind him.

LUKA

Pistachio Baclava for Cheryl.

A middle aged man enters: PAUL (40s).

LUKA (CONT'D)

Pistachio Baclava for Cheryl.

Paul approaches the counter.

PAUL

Hi-

LUKA

Pistachio Bac- 'scuse me- Pistachio Baclava for Cheryl.

No one replies...

PAUL

(dad-jokey)

I mean, if Cheryl's not here...

LUKA

Are you Cheryl?

PAUL

Do I look like a Cheryl?

LUKA

Don't assume.

PAUL

I... wha- it was about... my- myself-

LUKA

What can I get you?

PAUL

Actually for my son. He just moved in the area, so I'm visiting. Said he loves this place. Thought I'd surprise him-

LUKA

What does he want ...?

PAUL

Um... I think he likes a chai?

LUKA

We only have Chai Matchas-

PAUL

Is that a thing?

LUKA

Are you questioning a professional?

PAUL

Um- no, sorry. You're right, I guess I'll do one of those.

TIUKA

Okay, what kind of milk?

PAUL

Just whole is fine.

LUKE

Sir, you're at Nutmug, where we only offer nut based creamer and liquid options.

PAUL

That almost sounds dirty.

LUKA

Sir, you're in Bushwick, where everything is physically and/or metaphorically dirty.

PAUL

Did you, like, write that down?

Luka points at a Nutmug sign at the window... it's the slogan.

PAUL

Okay. I'll just assume... almond?

LUKA

Sorry, we're out of almond milk.

PAUL

It's like the most popular one.

LUKA

Hence low stock as corollary to high capitalistic nut demand.

PAUL

What?

LUKA

Would you like something else?

PAUL

How 'bout oat?

LUKA

Did you really just ask that?

PAUL

It's also popular!

LUKA

"Sir, you're at Nutmug, where we only offer nut based creamer and-"

PAUL

Okay, fine. Fine... what other nuts are there...?

(he thinks)

Um... Pistachio?

LUKA

We reserve our pistachios for pistachio based pastries-

PAUL

Peanut?

LUKA

In solidarity with the allergenic commune we try to abstain from offering peanut by up-charging.

PAUL

What's the up-charge?

LUKA

420 dollars.

PAUL

Wha-?! You can't charge like that!

LUKA

In capitalist America I can do anything if I work hard. I worked hard to come up with that number.

PAUL

How 'bout Hazelnut?

LUKA

No.

PAUL

"No?!"

LUKA

I don't like you very much.

Paul huffs in frustration. He stares down Luka.

PAUL

...y'know ,it doesn't even make sense, does it? Nuts being popular milks now. It's inefficient...

Luka just stares at Paul in response.

PAUL

It's not like a cow, straight from the source. You don't just crack it open and out pours-

Luka whistles. The barista appears holding a cup. She sets it on the counter. In her other hand she lifts a cashew and...

CRACK- splits it in half, a little bit of creamer falling out into the cup. She pulls up a Walnut- CRACK, she repeats. A pistachio- CRACK. A peanut- CRACK. A macadamia- CRACK. Pine-CRACK. Pecan- CRACK. A small bit of cream squirts out of all.

Luka grabs the cup of the counter and lowers it under the register, out of view. We hear a pant zip down, followed by an identical- CRACK and tiny pour.

Luka doesn't break his stare with Paul, jaw dropped.

LUKA

(to barista)

What was that, a small? That'll be 27 dollars. Would you like some cayenne pepper on top?

Paul hands his grateful son the chai.

SON

Dad! The surprise was enough, you didn't have to...

He takes a sip. Paul watches closely.

SON

Just how I like it! How'd you know? I love Nutmug-!

PAUL

I want you to move.
